Summary: Amends LVMC Chapter 11.48 to
further restrict the hours during which truck
traffic may move in residence districts.

11 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
12 AS FOLLOWS:

13 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 48, Section 50 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
14 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 **11.48.050:** No vehicle in excess of eight thousand pounds unladen weight shall be operated or
16 moved upon any street, [except truck routes, or] including a truck route, in any residence district
17 between the hours of [ten] seven p.m. and six a.m.; provided, however, that the Department of Public
18 Works may, at its discretion, upon application in writing, issue a special permit in writing authorizing
19 the applicant to operate or move such vehicle between the hours of [ten] seven p.m. and six a.m. In
20 issuing such permit, the Department may impose such conditions thereon, such as routes to be
21 followed, time of operation or movement, or other matters, as it [shall deem] deems necessary or
22 desirable.


23 SECTION 2: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared
24 to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is
25 required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a
26 misdemeanor, the doing of such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
27 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
28 \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of such
fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or

1 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
2 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
3 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
4 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection,
5 subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more
6 section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase be declared unconstitutional,
7 invalid or ineffective.


8 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases,


