Summary: Establishes limitations on the ability of
certain elected and appointed City officials to seek
elective office.

12 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
13 AS FOLLOWS:

14 SECTION 1: Title 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983
15 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new chapter consisting of the section that is set forth
16 as Section 2 of this Ordinance.

17 SECTION 2: No elected City official or official serving as an appointee on a City
18 board shall be eligible to file for election to any other City office without first having submitted a
19 resignation from his or her current position with the City. The resignation shall become effective
20 upon the date the person elected to the office filed for takes the oath of office.

21 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
22 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
23 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
24 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
25 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection,
26 subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more
27 sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared
28 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases,


