Summary: Eliminates the ability to obtain a waiver of the minimum 1500-foot distance requirements applicable to a tavern.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN

AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 19A.04.050(B) of the Zoning Code of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended in the manner described below:

Paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4 under the category "Liquor Establishment (Tavern)" are hereby amended by adding in front of each paragraph an asterisk (*). In accordance with Section 19A.04.050(A), the effect of adding the asterisks is to eliminate the ability of a proposed tavern to obtain a waiver of the minimum 1500-foot distance requirement between the tavern and a church, synagogue, school, child care facility licensed for more than twelve children, a City park or other tavern.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,




