17 adding thereto a new Chapter, designated as Chapter 2.51, con-  
18 taining the provision that is set forth as Section 2 of this  
19 Ordinance.

20 SECTION 2: A person is not eligible to serve on the  
21 Las Vegas Housing Authority Board, Las Vegas-Clark County Library  
22 District Board of Trustees, Planning Commission, Traffic and  
23 Parking Commission, Civil Service, Board of Zoning Adjustment,  
24 Child Care Licensing Board, Citizens Advisory Review Board, and  
25 Citizens Priority Advisory Committee, that are established by  
26 this Code or by City Council action unless he or she is a resi-  
27 dent of the City.

28 All non-residents of the City who are members of these  
29 boards or commissions on the date this ordinance becomes effec-  
30 tive shall be allowed to complete their terms of office.

31 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision,  
32 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any

1 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
2 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
3 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
4 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.  
5 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
6 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
7 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-  
8 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-  
9 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared  
10 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

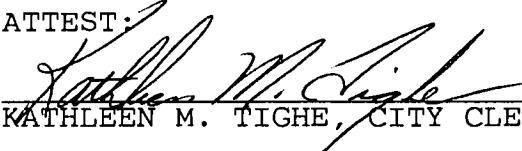

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA DOES  
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Chapter, designated as Chapter 2.51, containing the provision that is set forth as Section 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: A person is not eligible to serve on the Las Vegas Housing Authority Board, Las Vegas-Clark County Library District Board of Trustees, Planning Commission, Traffic and Parking Commission, Civil Service, Board of Zoning Adjustment, Child Care Licensing Board, Citizens Advisory Review Board, and Citizens Priority Advisory Committee, that are established by this Code or by City Council action unless he or she is a resident of the City.

All non-residents of the City who are members of these boards or commissions on the date this ordinance becomes effective shall be allowed to complete their terms of office.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any

1 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
2 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
3 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
4 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
