THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 16, Chapter 24, Section 10, of the
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

16.24.010: Those certain documents, three copies of each being
on file in the Office of the City Clerk and designated as
follows, are adopted by reference and made a part of this Code,
to the same effect as if set out herein in full:

- (A) Uniform Mechanical Code, [1985] 1988 Edition,
hereby designated as Part 1 of this Chapter; and
- (B) A supplemental document adding to, deleting from
and amending the Uniform Mechanical Code, [1985] 1988 Edition,
hereby designated as Part 2 of this Chapter.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or

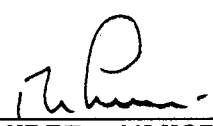
1 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
2 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
3 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
4 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
5 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
6 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-
7 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-
8 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
9 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

10 SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is
11 prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or
12 a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act
13 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
14 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such
15 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
16 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be
17 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
18 for a term of not more than six (6) months, or by any combination
19 of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this
20 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

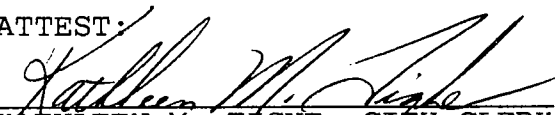

1 A SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENT AMENDING
2 THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE, 1988 EDITION

3 Section 1: Certain provisions of the Uniform Mechanical Code,
4 1988 Edition, shall be added to, deleted from and amended as
5 provided in Sections 2 to 19, inclusive, of this Supplemental
6 Document. Unless otherwise indicated, all section and
7 chapter references in this Supplemental Document are to the
8 Uniform Mechanical Code, 1988 Edition.

9 Section 2: Several provisions of this Code are similar or
10 parallel to provisions of the Uniform Administrative Code,
11 1988 Edition, as adopted by the City. Both codes shall be
12 applied to the extent possible. In the event of conflict,
13 the provisions of Section 106 of the Uniform Administrative
14 Code shall govern, unless otherwise deemed appropriate by the
15 Director of the Department of Building and Safety or his
16 designee.

17 Section 3: The Uniform Mechanical Code, 1988 Edition, is
18 hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions which are set
19 forth as Section 4 to 6, inclusive, of this Supplemental
20 Document.

21 Section 4: LICENSING: Any person, firm or corporation engaged
22 in the business of installing, repairing, servicing, main-
23 taining or improving heating and air conditioning equipment
24 or ductwork in the City of Las Vegas shall first secure a
25 State of Nevada Contractor's License and a City business
26 license. Those licenses must be kept valid as long as the
27 licensee is engaged in any business described in this Sec-
28 tion.

29 Section 5: QUALIFIED PERSONS:

30 (a) It is unlawful for any person to install, alter,
31 reconstruct, repair or maintain any heating, ventilating, air
32 conditioning or refrigeration equipment or evaporative cooler

1 or cooling tower as described in this Code, unless such per-
2 son is a qualified person or a regular salaried employee of a
3 qualified person, in which latter case the qualified person
4 shall be responsible for all work done by such employee.

5 (b) The term "qualified person" shall be deemed to mean
6 a person, firm or corporation who holds both a valid contrac-
7 tor's license issued by the State of Nevada and a valid City
8 business license or a person who qualifies under Subsection
9 (c) of this Section.

10 (c) Any permit required by this Code may be issued to
11 any person doing any construction or work regulated by this
12 Code in a single family dwelling used exclusively for living
13 purposes, including usual accessory buildings and quarters in
14 connection with such single family dwelling, provided:

15 (1) That such person is a bona fide owner of such
16 dwelling, accessory building and quarters;

17 (2) That the same are occupied by or intended to be
18 occupied by such owner; and

19 (3) That for the installation of any equipment, such
20 owner shall be required to apply for and obtain a
21 permit for such construction or work; provided
22 however, that no permit is required for the repair,
23 service or maintenance of existing equipment.

24 Section 6: NON-METALLIC PIPING:

25 Non-metallic piping systems which are part of any heating or
26 cooling systems (including condensate lines) shall be limited
27 to those structures where combustible construction is allowed
28 by the Uniform Building Code (Types III, IV and V).

29 Section 7: Section 301 is hereby amended by adding a new Sub-
30 section (c), reading as follows:

31 (c) Certain Heating Appliances. Notwithstanding
32 any other provision of this Section or of the Uniform

1 Administrative Code, a permit shall be required for any
2 heating appliance if such appliance is secured to the
3 structure by any means and is provided to meet the
4 heating requirements of Section 1212 of the Uniform
5 Building Code.

6 Section 8: Chapter 3 is hereby amended by deleting Table No.
7 3-A and adopting in lieu thereof a new Table No. 3-A, reading
8 as follows:

9 Table No. 3-A

10 (Fees shall be charged in accordance with the Fee Tables
11 contained in the Uniform Administrative Code, as adopted
12 by the City)

13 Section 9: Section 509 is hereby amended by adding thereto a
14 new sentence, reading as follows:

15 The 120V receptacle used for service and maintenance
16 purposes on commercial buildings, apartments,
17 townhouses, and condominiums shall be connected to the
18 house service.

19 EXCEPTION: Single family detached homes.

20 Section 10: Section 510(a) is hereby amended by adding thereto
21 a new sentence, reading as follows:

22 Where PVC Piping is allowed for condensate drains on
23 commercial buildings, that piping shall not be installed
24 on the exterior of the roofs.

25 Section 11: Section 708 is hereby amended by adding thereto two
26 new paragraphs, reading as follows:

27 No "blown-in" insulation shall be installed within six
28 feet (6') of any gas fired attic furnace.

29
30 Truss calculations must show method of support for attic
31 furnaces within trusses.

32 Section 12: Section 710(a) is hereby amended by adding thereto

1 a new paragraph, reading as follows:

2 When appliances are installed on a roof, a minimum of
3 three (3) trusses must be spanned. Engineering calcula-
4 tions may be required by the Building Official to
5 justify the placement of the equipment.

6 Section 13: Section 710 is hereby amended by deleting Subsec-
7 tion (e) in its entirety and adopting in lieu thereof a new
8 Subsection (e), reading as follows:

9 (e) Platform. A furnace located on a roof shall
10 be installed on a substantial level platform. When the
11 roof has a slope greater than 5 in 12, a level working
12 platform at least 30 inches in depth shall be provided
13 along the firebox and control sides of the furnace.
14 Sides of a working platform facing the roof edge below
15 shall be protected by a substantial railing 42 inches in
16 height with vertical rails not more than 21 inches
17 apart, except that parapets at least 24 inches in height
18 may be utilized in lieu of rails or guards.

19 Section 14: Section 710 is hereby amended by deleting Subsec-
20 tion (f) in its entirety and adopting in lieu thereof a new
21 Subsection (f), reading as follows:

22 (f) Catwalk. On roofs having slopes greater than
23 5 in 12, a catwalk at least sixteen inches (16") in
24 width with cleats spaced not more than sixteen inches
25 (16") apart shall be provided from the roof access to
26 the working platform at the appliance.

27 Section 15: Section 710(h) is hereby amended by deleting
28 Exception 2 and adopting in lieu thereof a new Exception 2,
29 reading as follows:

30 2. A portable ladder may be used for access to
31 appliances on the single story portion (not to exceed
32 sixteen feet (16') in height) of any occupancy regulated

1 by the Uniform Building Code.

2 Section 16: Section 803 is hereby amended by adding thereto a
3 new Item 5, reading as follows:

4 5. In single family residences, natural gas supply
5 lines and valves shall be provided to built-in fire-
6 places when natural gas is provided to the structure for
7 other gas burning appliances.

8 Section 17: Section 1205 is hereby amended by adding thereto a
9 new sentence, reading as follows:

10 In buildings of combustible construction, condensate
11 drains using PVC pipe shall be Schedule 40.

12 Section 18: Section 2003 is hereby amended by deleting Subsec-
13 tion (k) and adopting in lieu thereof a new Subsection (k),
14 reading as follows:

15 (k) Performance Test. Upon completion and before
16 final approval of the installation of a ventilation
17 system serving commercial food heat-processing equip-
18 ment, a performance test shall be required to verify the
19 rate of airflow and proper operation as specified in
20 this Chapter. The test shall be performed by the
21 contractor or a testing firm and a copy of the test
22 shall be provided to the Building Official before final
23 approval can be granted. The permittee shall be respon-
24 sible for furnishing the necessary test equipment and
25 devices that are required to perform the tests.

26 Section 19: Section 2004(b) is hereby amended by adding
27 thereto, following the Exception, a new sentence, reading as
28 follows:

29 The Department of Fire Services will enforce the
30 installation of fire extinguishing equipment for all
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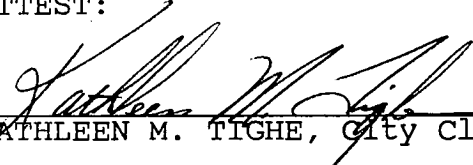
commercial kitchen grease hoods, ducts and other matters properly related thereto.
