ORDINANCE NO. 3786

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COLLECTION, HAULING AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE; AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 8, SECTIONS 140, 150, 160 AND 170, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO ESTABLISH A REVISED RATE OF CHARGES FOR COLLECTING, HAULING AND DISPOSING OF GARBAGE WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF SAID CITY EITHER BY SAID CITY OR BY ITS AUTHORIZED CONTRACTOR; ADDING A NEW SECTION TO SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER PROVIDING THAT SAID REVISED RATES FOR COLLECTION CHARGES BECOME EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 1994; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Establishes a revised rate of charges for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals, effective April 1, 1994.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 140, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.08.140: The charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals from single-family residences on a twice-a-week basis shall be as follows: [twenty-four dollars and forty-five cents] twenty-nine dollars and ten cents per quarter, payable in advance, each and every three-month period.

SECTION 2: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 150, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.08.150: The charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals from apartments and multiple units on a twice-a-week basis shall be a flat rate to be computed as follows: [eighteen dollars and twenty-two cents] twenty-one dollars and sixty-nine cents for the first unit on one stop and [twelve dollars and seventy-six cents] fifteen dollars and

1 nineteen cents for each additional unit on one stop, irrespective of occupancy or vacancy of any
2 such additional unit or units, payable each and every three-month period. Should
3 three-days-a-week service be requested by any apartments or multiple units, the rate for such
4 service shall be one and one-half times that for service on a twice-a-week basis and should
5 six-days-a-week service be requested by any apartments or multiple units, the rate for such service
6 shall be two and one-half times that for service on a twice-a-week basis.

7 SECTION 3: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of the
8 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 9.08.160: The charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small
10 dead animals from motels and mobile home parks on a twice-a-week basis, shall be as follows:

11 Offices [18.22] 21.69 per quarter;

12 Sleeping rooms and mobile homes
13 without cooking facilities [8.30] \$10.44 per quarter;

14 Rooms where cooking facilities are
15 furnished or mobile homes with
cooking facilities [10.95] \$13.03 per quarter; and

16 Mobile home parks that require individual collection at each mobile home, the service will be the
17 same as residential service with a heavy item pick up provided, and the rate shall be [twenty-four
18 dollars and forty-five cents] twenty-nine dollars and ten cents per unit per quarter; provided,
19 however, that the rate for such individual collection without the heavy item pick up shall be
20 [eighteen dollars and twenty-two cents] twenty-one dollars and sixty-nine cents per unit per
21 quarter. Should three-day-a-week service be requested by any motel or mobile home park, the
22 rate for such service shall be one and one-half times that for service on a twice-a-week basis and
23 should six-days-a-week service be requested by any motel or mobile home park, the rate for such
24 service shall be two and one-half times that for service on a twice-a-week basis.

25 SECTION 4: Title 9, Chapter 8, Section 170, of the Municipal Code of the
26 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.08.170: The quarterly charge for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animals from hotels, places of business and public buildings shall be determined by the number and type of receptacles required by each such hotel, place of business or public building and by the number of collections from each per week in accordance with the following table:

Compacted garbage and refuse shall be billed at the ratio of three to one in accordance with the size of the container and frequency of service.

SECTION 5: Title 9, Chapter 8, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a new section reading as follows:

The revised rates for collecting, hauling and disposing of garbage, rubbish, dirt and small dead animal as set forth in SECTIONS 1 through 4, inclusive, shall be effective as of April 1, 1994.

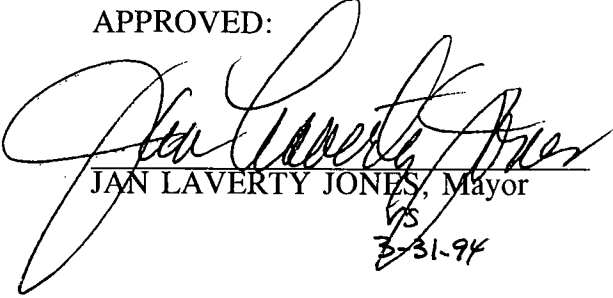
SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las . . .

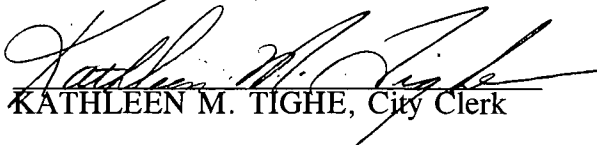
