AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ROCK CONCERTS; REPEALING SECTION 20 OF CHAPTER 73 OF TITLE 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION; AMENDING CHAPTER 73 OF SAID TITLE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION, DESIGNATED AS SECTION 20, TO PROVIDE A NEW DEFINITION OF THE TERM "ROCK CONCERT"; AMENDING SECTION 50 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO MAKE CERTAIN TECHNICAL CHANGES THEREIN; AMENDING SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER FURTHER BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION EXEMPTING OWNERS, OPERATORS AND LESSEES OF CASINOS, HOTELS, THEATERS OR OTHER PERMANENT FACILITIES WHO ARE OTHERWISE LICENSED TO DO BUSINESS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 6 FROM ROCK CONCERT LICENSING AND PERMIT REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THEIR OWN ESTABLISHMENTS; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Amends LVMC Chapter 6.73 by redefining the term "rock concert" and exempting the owners, operators and lessees of certain permanent facilities from rock concert licensing and permit requirements.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 20 of Chapter 73 of Title 6 of the the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 73, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.73.020: (A) As used in this Chapter, unless the context otherwise requires, "rock concert" means:

(1) A public rendition of music;

(2) Which is characterized by a persistent, heavily accented beat;

(3) Produced by professional musicians using electronically amplified instruments where the sound pressure level meets or exceeds 110 dB, "A Weighted," at thirty feet from the front of the stage at any time during the performance; and

1 (4) To which members of the public are invited.

2 (B) The term "rock concert" does not include ballets,
3 jazz concerts, operas or theatrical presentations, or perfor-
4 mances of adult contemporary, classical, country/western or
5 gospel music.

6 SECTION 3: Title 6, Chapter 73, Section 50, of the
7 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
8 hereby amended to read as follows:

9 6.73.050: The requirement for a license or permit for a rock
10 concert as herein provided may be waived by the City Council
11 for a recognized charitable, educational or governmental
12 organization when it appears to the satisfaction of the
13 Council that the anticipated [crowd] audience is relatively
14 small in number, that the event will be properly supervised
15 and the facilities are suitable.

16 SECTION 4: Title 6, Chapter 73, of the Municipal Code
17 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended
18 by adding thereto a new Section reading as set forth in Section 5
19 hereof.

20 SECTION 5: The requirement for a license or permit as
21 herein provided for a rock concert does not apply to a musical
22 performance conducted, promoted or staged by the owner, operator
23 or lessee of a casino, hotel, theater or other permanent faci-
24 lity in such facility, if:

25 (A) The owner, operator or lessee is otherwise
26 licensed to do business pursuant to the provisions of this
27 Title;

28 (B) The audience does not exceed a seating capacity of
29 one thousand persons; and

30 (C) A minimum of one security officer per every two
31 hundred persons is employed to supervise the audience.

32 SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision,

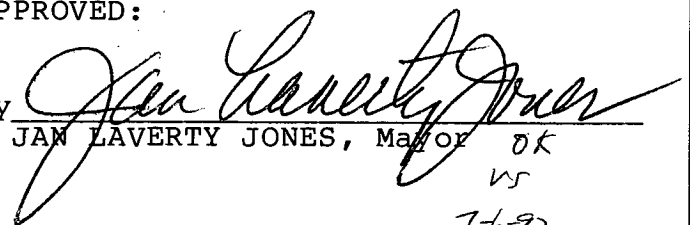
1 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
2 part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
3 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
4 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
5 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
6 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
7 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
8 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof
9 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
10 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases
11 be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

12 SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
13 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
14 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
15 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

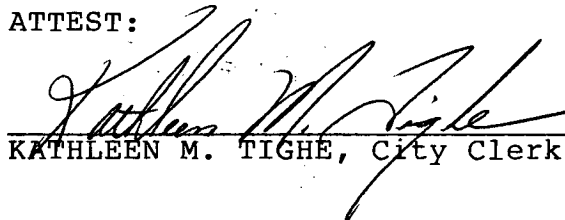

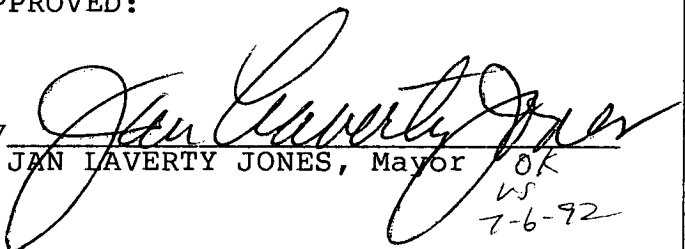

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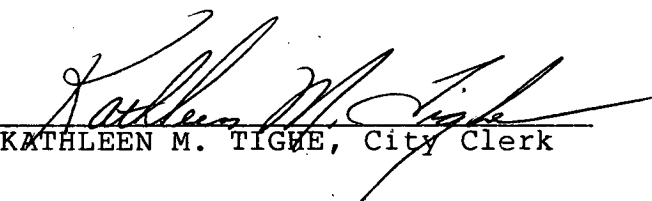

23 SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 73, of the Municipal Code
24 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended
25 by adding thereto a new Section, designated as Section 20,
26 reading as set forth in Section 3 hereof.

27 SECTION 3: 6.73.020: (A) As used in this Chapter,
28 unless the context otherwise requires, "rock concert" means:

- 29 (1) A public rendition of music;
30 (2) Which is characterized by a persistent,
31 heavily accented beat;
32 (3) Produced by professional musicians using

1 electronically amplified instruments where the sound pressure
2 level meets or exceeds 110 dB, "A Weighted," at thirty feet from
3 the front of the stage at any time during the performance; and

4 (4) To which members of the public are invited.

5 (B) The term "rock concert" does not include ballets,
6 jazz concerts, operas or theatrical presentations, or perform-
7 ances of adult contemporary, classical, country/western or
8 gospel, music.

9 SECTION 4: Title 6, Chapter 73, Section 50, of the

13 Ordinance, [The] the requirement for a license or permit
14 for a rock concert as herein provided may be waived by
15 the City Council for a recognized charitable, educa-
16 tional or governmental organization when it appears to
17 the satisfaction of the Council that the anticipated
18 [crowd] audience is relatively small in number, that the
19 event will be properly supervised and the facilities are
20 suitable.

21 SECTION 5: Title 6, Chapter 73, of the Municipal Code
22 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended
23 by adding thereto a new Section reading as follows:

24 The requirement for a license or permit as herein pro-
25 vided for a rock concert does not apply to a musical
26 performance conducted, promoted or staged by:

27 (A) A recognized charitable, educational or govern-
28 mental organization within a casino, hotel, theater or
29 permanent facility; or

30 (B) The owner, operator or lessee of a casino,
31 hotel, theater or other permanent facility in such faci-
32 lity, if:

1 (1) The owner, operator or lessee is other-
2 wise licensed to do business pursuant to the provisions
3 of this Title;

4 (2) The audience does not exceed a seating
5 capacity of one thousand persons; and

6 (3) A minimum of one security officer per
7 every two hundred persons is employed to supervise the
8 audience.

9 SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
10 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
11 part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
12 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
13 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
14 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
15 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
16 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
17 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof
18 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
19 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases
20 be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

21 SECTION 7: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohi-
22 bited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a
23 misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act
24 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
25 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of such
26 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
27 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be
28 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
29 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of
30 such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this
31 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

32 SECTION 8: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-

1 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
2 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
3 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
