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18 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
19 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

20 SECTION 1: Title 10, Chapter 10, of the Municipal Code
21 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended
22 by adding thereto the provisions that are set forth as Sections 2
23 through 7, inclusive, of this ordinance.

24 SECTION 2: It is unlawful for any consultant, dog
25 handler, private investigator, private patrolman, process server,
26 reposessor, security consultant or security guard as defined in
27 Chapter 648 of NRS or any employee of any such persons to:

28 (A) Use or carry a badge until the badge has been
29 approved by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and
30 until such time as a photograph of the badge has been filed with
31 the police department;

32 (B) Use or wear a uniform until the uniform has been

1 approved by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and
2 until such time as a colored photograph of the uniform has been
3 filed with the police department;

4 (C) Use a vehicle in his business or employment, other
5 than a vehicle with standard factory colors and markings, having
6 a unique or customized color scheme or markings until the color
7 scheme and markings of the vehicle have been approved by the Las
8 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department.

9 SECTION 3: The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department
10 shall not withhold approval of any badge, uniform or vehicle
11 design, color scheme or logo if the badge, uniform or vehicle
12 would not give the impression that a consultant, dog handler,
13 private investigator, private patrolman, process server,
14 reposessor, security consultant or security guard as defined in
15 Chapter 648 of NRS or any employee of any such persons was a
16 peace officer or confuse a member of the public regarding the
17 authority of such persons.

18 SECTION 4: It is unlawful for any person to willfully
19 exhibit, use or wear or willfully give, lend, make, sell or
20 transfer to another any badge, device, emblem, insignia or any
21 card, certificate, label or writing, or to design, sell or use
22 any vehicle which falsely purports to be authorized for the use
23 of one who by law is given the authority of a peace officer or
24 which so resembles the authorized badge, card, certificate,
25 device, emblem, insignia, label, uniform or vehicle of a peace
26 officer as would deceive an ordinarily reasonable person into
27 believing that it is authorized for the use of one who by law is
28 given authority of a peace officer.

29 SECTION 5: (A) No person may be employed by a con-
30 sultant, dog handler, private investigator, private patrolman,
31 process server, reposessor, security consultant or security
32 guard as defined in Chapter 648 of NRS without first obtaining

1 and thereafter maintaining a valid, unexpired work card pursuant
2 to Chapter 6.86 of this Code.

3 (B) The provisions of this section do not apply to a
4 person licensed pursuant to Chapter 648 of NRS.

5 SECTION 6: It is unlawful for any person to:

6 (A) Allow an employee, including an independent
7 contractor, to perform any work as a security guard as defined in
8 Chapter 648 of NRS without requiring the employee to first
9 obtain and thereafter maintain a valid, unexpired work card pur-
10 suant to Chapter 6.86 of this Code.

11 (B) Work as a security guard as defined in Chapter 648
12 of NRS without first obtaining and thereafter maintaining a
13 valid, unexpired work card pursuant to Chapter 6.86 of this
14 Code.

15 (C) The provisions of this section do not apply to a
16 person licensed pursuant to Chapter 648 of NRS.

17 SECTION 7: This Chapter does not apply to:

18 (A) Polygraph examiners and interns as defined in
19 Chapter 648 of NRS; or

20 (B) Those persons exempted from the provisions of
21 Chapter 648 by NRS 648.018.

22 SECTION 8: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
23 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
24 part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
25 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
26 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
27 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.

28 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
29 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
30 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof
31 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
32 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases

1 be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

2 SECTION 9: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohi-
3 bited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a
4 misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act
5 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
6 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of such
7 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
8 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be
9 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
10 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of
11 such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this
12 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

13 SECTION 10: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
14 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
15 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
16 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It is unlawful for any consultant, dog handler, private investigator, private patrolman, process server, reposessor, security consultant or security guard as defined in Chapter 648 of NRS or any employee of any such persons to:

(A) Use or carry a badge until the badge has been approved by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and until such time as a photograph of the badge has been filed with the police department;

(B) Use or wear a uniform until the uniform has been approved by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and until such time as a colored photograph of the uniform has been filed with the police department;

(C) Use a vehicle in his business or employment, other

1 than a vehicle with standard factory colors and markings, having
2 a unique or customized color scheme or markings until the color
3 scheme and markings of the vehicle have been approved by the Las
4 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department.

5 SECTION 2: The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department
6 shall not withhold approval of any badge, uniform or vehicle
7 design, color scheme or logo if the badge, uniform or vehicle
8 would not give the impression that a consultant, dog handler,
9 private investigator, private patrolman, process server,
10 reposessor, security consultant or security guard as defined in
11 Chapter 648 of NRS or any employee of any such persons was a
12 peace officer or confuse a member of the public regarding the
13 authority of such persons.

14 SECTION 3: It is unlawful for any person to willfully
15 exhibit, use or wear or willfully give, lend, make, sell or

25 SECTION 4: (A) No person may be employed by a con-

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SECTION 5: It is unlawful for any person to:

(A) Allow an employee, including an independent contractor, to perform any work as a security guard as defined in Chapter 648 of NRS without requiring the employee to first obtain and thereafter maintain a valid, unexpired work card pursuant to Chapter 6.86 of this Code.

(B) Work as a security guard as defined in Chapter 648 of NRS without first obtaining and thereafter maintaining a valid, unexpired work card pursuant to Chapter 6.86 of this Code.

(C) The provisions of this section do not apply to a person licensed pursuant to Chapter 648 of NRS.

SECTION 6: This Chapter does not apply to:

(A) Polygraph examiners and interns as defined in Chapter 648 of NRS; or

(B) Those persons exempted from the provisions of Chapter 648 by NRS 648.018.

SECTION 7: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.

The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 8: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act

1 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
2 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of such
3 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
4 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be
5 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
6 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of
7 such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this
8 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

9 SECTION 9: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
10 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
11 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
12 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

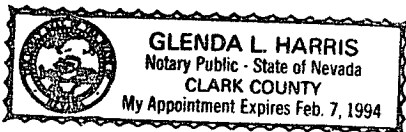

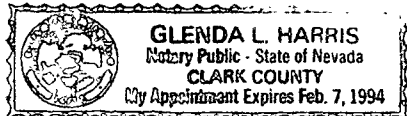
