AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SEWER SERVICE SURCHARGES; AMENDING TITLE 14, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 30, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF THE SURCHARGE FROM \$2.51 TO \$2.30 PER EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL UNIT; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

Summary: Reduces rate per equivalent residential unit for sewer service surcharges.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 14, Chapter 4, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

14.04.160: There is established and imposed upon the customers of the City's sewage disposal system, effective as of [July 1, 1991] July 1, 1992, a surcharge in the amount of two dollars and [fifty-one] thirty cents per equivalent residential unit. Each customer shall pay to the City annually, as his, her or its proportionate share of the service [charge] surcharge due from the City to Clark County pursuant to Clark County Ordinance No. 730, an amount equal to two dollars and [fifty-one] thirty cents multiplied by the number of equivalent residential units charged to such customer. The surcharge shall be billed annually to each customer of the city's sewage disposal system, including those customers whose properties are hereafter connected thereto, at the same time as the customer's regular sewer charge and shall apply to the calendar year in which it is billed; provided, however, that the amount of such surcharge may hereafter be adjusted from time to time to reflect any change effected by Clark County in such service charge pursuant to Section 4(B) to 4(D), inclusive, of Clark County Ordinance No. 730.

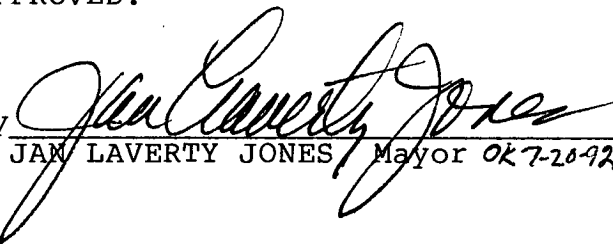
1 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
3 part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
4 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
5 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
6 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
7 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
8 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
9 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof
10 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
11 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases
12 be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

13 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
14 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
15 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
16 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

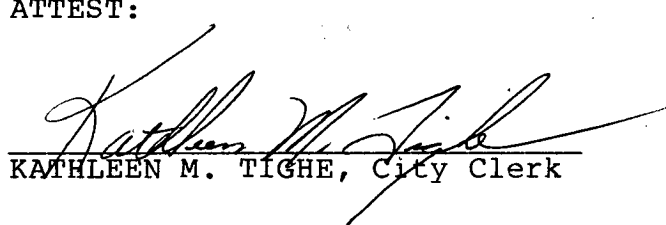
