THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 50, Section 225, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.50.225: Applicants for a permit to provide liquor catering services shall comply with the following provisions:

(A) An application for a permit may be made only by a person who holds a valid liquor caterer license.

(B) The application shall be made to the Department on forms provided by it, not less than three days prior to the proposed event[.] unless otherwise authorized by the Director of the Department or his designee upon the applicant showing the impracticability of his compliance with the advance filing requirement.

(C) The application shall set forth the following information:

- (1) Name and address of the applicant;
- (2) Date, hours, address and description of the event;
- (3) Approximate number of persons to be in attendance;

- 1 (4) Type of alcoholic beverages to be served; and
2 (5) The name of the sponsor of the event.

3 (D) Each event requires a separate permit.

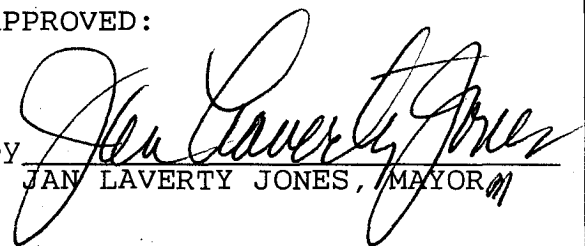
4 (E) A permit fee of twenty-five dollars per day for
5 each day of the event must be paid when the application for per-
6 mit is filed.

7 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
8 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
9 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
10 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
11 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
12 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
13 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
14 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
15 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-
16 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-
17 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
18 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

19 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
20 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
21 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
22 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
