

ORDINANCE NO. 1703

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE I OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER, HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED AS "CHAPTER 22 - ELECTIVE OFFICERS", BY PROVIDING FOR FILING FEES FOR CANDIDATES FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICES; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, Section 5.010, Subsection 5 of the Charter of the City of Las Vegas, provides that the filing fee for each elective office of the City of Las Vegas shall be established by Ordinance by the Board of Commissioners:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title I of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a new Chapter, designated as Chapter 22 - Elective Officers, and to read as follows:

CHAPTER 22
ELECTIVE OFFICERS

1-22-1

Candidates for the following municipal offices shall pay the following designated filing fee at the time of filing their Affidavit of Candidacy:


- a) Mayor. \$50.00
- b) Board of Commissioners \$50.00
- c) City Attorney. \$50.00
- d) Municipal Judge. \$50.00

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, term, word, or connotation of this ordinance, or portion thereof, is for any reason held invalid, inapplicable, or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate

invalidate the remaining portions of this ordinance.



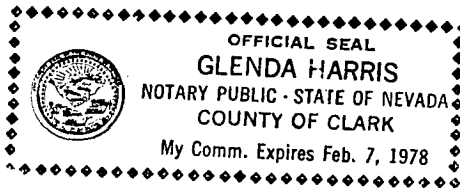
