

ORDINANCE NO. 1555

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE V, CHAPTER 17, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION TO BE DESIGNATED SECTION 20, PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL EVENTS LICENSE, PROVIDING REGULATION AND FEE THEREFOR, AND TO ALLOW BINGO GAMES BY CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF A GAMING LICENSE; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title V, Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, 1960 Edition is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated Section 20 to read as follows:

5-17-20 Any charitable organization after obtaining a charitable solicitation permit may, without the necessity of having a gaming license as provided in Section 1 of this Chapter, conduct and maintain bingo games at either the permanent address and location of said charitable organization and/or any place of business which has an unrestricted gambling license. No charitable organization may hold such a bingo party more frequently than once every three (3) months.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.


SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

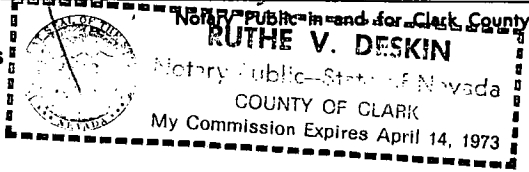
