

ORDINANCE NO. 1538

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XI, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 25 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SUBSECTION DESIGNATED SUBSECTION 25.6 TO PROVIDE FOR A FILING FEE FOR STREET NAME CHANGE APPLICATIONS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title XI, Chapter 1, Section 25 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Subsection designated 25.6 to read as follows:

11-1-25.6: STREET NAME CHANGES

- (A) Applications: Two (2) copies of a petition signed by three (3) freeholders requesting the change and describing the limits of the proposed change. The application shall be filed with the secretary of the Planning Commission. The person filing the petition should reside within an area which would be effected by the change.
- (B) Filing Fee: To partially defray the cost of making maps, sending out notices and other administrative and investigative expenses, the secretary of the Planning Commission is authorized to charge a fee, payable to the City, in the amount of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00).

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

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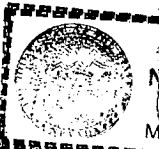
SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or
