

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VI, CHAPTER 8, SECTION 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1960 EDITION, BY CLARIFYING THE AGES OF CITIZENS ENCOMPASSED WITHIN THE TWELVE O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT CURFEW ON SCHOOL HOLIDAYS AND DURING THE SUMMER VACATION; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 8, Section 6 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6-8-6 CURFEW: It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of eighteen (18) years, without being on any lawful business or engaged in any lawful occupation, not accompanied by one of his parents or his guardian, or other adult person having legal care, custody and control of said child, to loiter, idle, wander or stroll or be upon, in or about any of the public streets, avenues, alleys, or other public places in the City at any time between the hours of ten o'clock (10:00) P.M., Sunday through Thursday and five o'clock (5:00) A.M. of the succeeding day, and between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) Midnight, on Friday and Saturday, and five o'clock (5:00) A.M. of the succeeding day; provided, however, the Chief of Police shall be empowered to extend the curfew on special occasions to such hour as shall be designated by him.

And it shall be as such that on all school holidays and during the days of summer vacation, said curfew shall be between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) Midnight, and five o'clock (5:00) A.M. for all citizens under the age of eighteen (18) years.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.


