

FIRST AMENDMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 1530

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XI, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 8, SUBSECTION (B), PARAGRAPH 1, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH TO BE DESIGNATED PARAGRAPH (c) PROVIDING FOR HEIGHT RESTRICTION FOR OFF-PREMISE SIGNS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title XI, Chapter 3, Section 8, Subsection (B), Paragraph 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph to be designated paragraph (c) to read as follows:

11-3-8 (B) 1. (c) Height - no higher than forty (40) feet from grade
at point of construction.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.


SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.



ORDINANCE NO. 1530
 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XI, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION (B), PARAGRAPH 1, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERE-TO A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH TO BE DESIGNATED PARAGRAPH (C) PROVIDING FOR HEIGHT RESTRICTION FOR OFF-PREMISE SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING HERETO; PROVIDING FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title XI, Chapter 3, Section 3, Subsection (B), Paragraph 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subparagraph to be designated paragraph (c) to read as follows: "1-38 (B) 1. (c) Height no higher than forty (40) feet from grade at point of construction."

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
