

ORDINANCE NO. 1528

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE III, CHAPTER 5, SECTIONS 2, 3, 4 & 5 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO BRING FEES FOR POLICE SERVICES NOT COVERED ELSEWHERE WITHIN THE CITY ORDINANCE IN LINE WITH CURRENT COSTS TO THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. 1528

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title III, Chapter 5, Sections 2, 3, 4 & 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, are hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

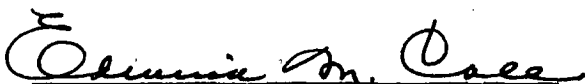

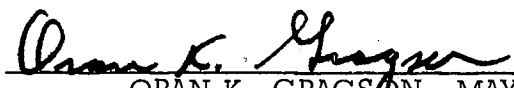

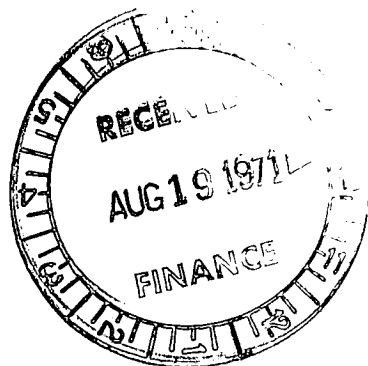

ORDINANCE NO. 1528
An Ordinance to Amend Title III, Chapter 5; Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, to Bring Fees for Police Services Not Covered Elsewhere Within the City Ordinance in Line With Current Costs to the City of Las Vegas; Providing Other Matters Properly Relating Thereto; Providing Penalties for the Violation Hereof, and Repealing All Ordinances and Parts of Ordinances in Conflict Herewith. THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title III, Chapter 5, Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, are hereby amended to read as follows:

3-5-2:

TRAFFIC SERVICES

- (A) Motorcycle funeral escorts \$20.00 per man hour
- (B) Motorcycle escorts for housemoving on City streets 20.00 per man hour
- (C) Special traffic control necessitated by private construction activity 20.00 per man-hour
- (D) Reproduction of traffic reports—including file being pulled 3.00 for first (3) pages .25 each additional page

3-5-3:

RECORDS SERVICES

- (A) Simple name check \$.50 each
- (B) Full record check 2.00 each
- (C) Reproduction of reports—including file being pulled 3.00 for first (3) pages .25 each additional page

3-5-4:

IDENTIFICATION SERVICES

- (A) Processing fingerprint cards \$ 2.00 each
- (B) Printing photographs 3.50 each

3-5-5:

SPECIAL SERVICES

- (A) Assignment to athletic events, dances and other special services:
 - (1) Police officer \$6.48 per man-hour
- (B) Any special service undertaken but not specifically provided for herein shall be assessed at a rate not to exceed twenty dollars (\$20.) per man hour and approved by the City Manager.
- (C) Any salary and/or operational increases that may occur will be adjusted accordingly within the schedule of fees as set forth within this Chapter.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.
