

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE, AND RE-ENACT SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 292 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS AMENDED, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 292 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled: "An ordinance providing for the protection of the public health, and the examination, registration, licensing and bonding of persons engaged in the business of plumbing, or laboring at the trade of plumbing; requiring a permit for the installation or alteration of plumbing and drainage systems; creating the office of plumbing inspector and a board of Plumber Examiners, and prescribing their duties; defining certain terms: establishing minimum regulations for the installation, alteration or repair of plumbing and drainage systems and the inspection thereof; providing penalties for its violation and repealing conflicting ordinances", shall be and the same is hereby amended, revised and re-enacted so that the same shall as follows:

"Section 1: That a certain document three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas, being marked and designated as Standard Plumbing Code, published by Western Plumbing and Heating Journal the and the same is hereby referred to and adopted as the Plumbing Code of the City of Las Vegas for the protection of the public health, the examination, registration, licensing and bonding of persons engaged in the business of plumbing or laboring at the trade of plumbing, regulating the installation or alteration or repair of plumbing and drainage systems and the inspection thereof, creating the office of Plumbing Inspector and a Board of Plumber Examiners and prescribing their duties; providing penalties for violation of such plumbing code; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of such "Standard Plumbing Code, published by Western Plumbing and Heating Journal" on file in the office of the City Clerk are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, but it is specifically provided that neither this ordinance

or any repeal hereby provided shall in any way affect in any way any prosecution for the violation of any ordinance heretofore passed, pending at the time of the adoption of this ordinance.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, adoption and publication for two (2) successive issues in the Las Vegas Evening Review-Journal, a daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Las Vegas.

Section 4: The City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas is hereby authorized and directed to have this City Ordinance published in the Las Vegas Evening Review-Journal, a daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, for a period of two (2) weeks, that is to say, once each week for a period of two (2) weeks.

An ordinance to amend, revise and re-enact Section 1 of Ordinance No. 292 of the City of Las Vegas, as amended, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

Section 1.
