2 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE, AND RE-ENACT SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 292 OF  
3 THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS AMENDED, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF  
4 ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

5 The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, do ordain as follows:

6 Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 292 of the City of Las Vegas,  
7 entitled: "An ordinance providing for the protection of the public health, and  
8 the examination, registration, licensing and bonding of persons engaged in the  
9 business of plumbing, or laboring at the trade of plumbing; requiring a permit for  
10 the installation or alteration of plumbing and drainage systems; creating  
11 the office of plumbing inspector and a board of Plumber Examiners, and pre-  
12 scribing their duties; defining certain terms: establishing minimum regulations  
13 for the installation, alteration or repair of plumbing and drainage systems  
14 and the inspection thereof; providing penalties for its violation and repealing  
15 conflicting ordinances", shall be and the same is hereby amended, revised and  
16 re-enacted so that the same shall as follows:

17 "Section 1: That a certain document three (3) copies of which are  
18 on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas, being marked  
19 and designated as Standard Plumbing Code, published by Western Plumbing and  
20 Heating Journal the and the same is hereby referred to and adopted as the  
21 Plumbing Code of the City of Las Vegas for the protection of the public health,  
22 the examination, registration, licensing and bonding of persons engaged in  
23 the business of plumbing or laboring at the trade of plumbing, regulating the  
24 installation or alteration or repair of plumbing and drainage systems and the  
25 inspection thereof, creating the office of Plumbing Inspector and a Board of  
26 Plumber Examiners and prescribing their duties; providing penalties for viola-  
27 tion of such plumbing code; and each and all of the regulations, provisions,  
28 penalties, conditions and terms of such "Standard Plumbing Code, published by  
29 Western Plumbing and Heating Journal" on file in the office of the City Clerk  
30 are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in  
31 this ordinance.

32 Section 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith  
are hereby repealed, but it is specifically provided that neither this ordinance

1 or any repeal hereby provided shall in any way effect in any way any prosecution  
2 for the violation of any ordinance heretofore passed, pending at the time of

4 Section 3: This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage,

An ordinance to amend, revise and re-enact Section 1 of Ordinance No. 292 of the City of Las Vegas, as amended, and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

Section 1.
