14 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
15 AS FOLLOWS:

16 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 52, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas,
17 Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, reading as follows:

18 No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in a street for the purpose of engaging or
19 soliciting the employment of a pedestrian.


20 SECTION 2: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared
21 to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is
22 required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a
23 misdemeanor, the doing of such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
24 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
25 \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of such
26 fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

27 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause
28 or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City
Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section,

1 subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that
2 any one or more section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase be declared
3 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

4 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases,
5 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas,
6 Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



9 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN

10 AS FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 30, Section 110 of the Municipal Code of the City of
12 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 **11.30.110:** Except as otherwise provided by statute or ordinance. [No] no person shall
14 stand in a roadway or on a public sidewalk for the purpose of [soliciting]:

15 (A) Soliciting a ride, or

16 (B) Soliciting or accepting employment [,] or other business from the occupant
17 of any vehicle.

18 SECTION 2: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared
19 to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is
20 required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a
21 misdemeanor, the doing of such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
22 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
23 \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of such
24 fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

25 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause
26 or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
27 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
28 validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City
