13 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
14 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

15 SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 46, of the Municipal
16 Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby
17 amended by adding thereto three new sections containing the pro-
18 visions set forth as Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this Ordinance.

19 SECTION 2: Every person within the City of Las Vegas
20 who keeps, maintain, or controls any hotel, inn, motel, motor-
21 court, boardinghouse or lodging house wherein rooms are rented on
22 a daily weekly basis shall provide, keep and maintain a public
23 register and shall require every person who rents or occupies a
24 room in such hotel, inn, motel, motorcourt, boardinghouse or
25 lodging house to write in such register his name and place of
26 residence. Such registration shall be made on a page of the
27 register properly dated with reference to the day of the year,
28 month and week and the time of day the person rents or arranges
29 to occupy a room shall also be therein entered. Such register
30 shall be permanently and firmly bound and shall not be of a
31 loose-leaf nature.

32 SECTION 3: Such hotel, inn, motel, motorcourt, boar-

1 dinghouse or lodging house register so kept shall be open to the
2 public at any and all reasonable hours and the pages thereof
3 shall, upon demand, be open for inspection or investigation by
4 any law enforcement officer in Las Vegas immediately upon demand
5 having been made by such law enforcement officer.

6 SECTION 4: Any violation of this chapter constitutes
7 a misdemeanor and the offender shall be punished by a fine of not
8 more than one thousand dollars or imprisonment for not more than
9 six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

10 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
11 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
12 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
13 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
14 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
15 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
16 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
17 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
18 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-
19 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-
20 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
21 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

22 SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
23 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
24 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
25 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

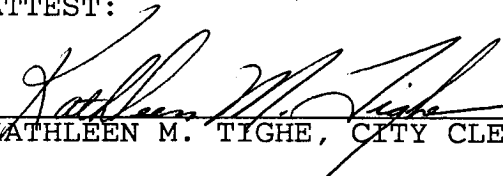
