AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 675 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SALES OF HYPODERMIC SYRINGES OR NEEDLES EXCEPT TO DULY AUTHORIZED PERSONS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR ILLEGAL POSSESSION THEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO."

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

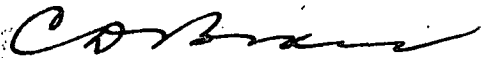
SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 675 is hereby repealed.
