ORDINANCE NO. 5241

AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE FEES CHARGED FOR TAXISTAND PERMITS, DESIGNATING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AS THE TAXISTAND PERMIT ISSUING AUTHORITY, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

Summary: Repeals taxistand permit fee provisions.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 60, Section 70, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11.60.070: Any cab company which desires to occupy [such stands]taxistands shall first file an application therefore with the [City Manager] Director of Public Works and be issued a permit to occupy the same.[upon the payment to the Director of Business Activity to be paid by him over to the Treasurer, of the fee of one dollar per month for each cab operated by such cab company.] All such permits so issued shall expire on May 31st and November 30th next ensuing the date of the issuance thereof, [or sooner upon the revocation of the vehicle license, as heretofore provided or as] unless otherwise provided by the provisions of this Code.

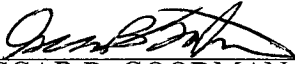
SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,

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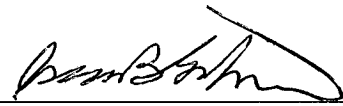

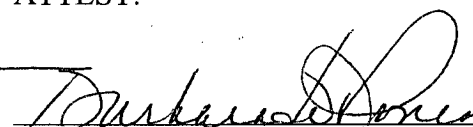

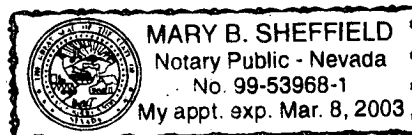
