ORDINANCE NO. 5247

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE DEPARTMENT OF FIELD OPERATIONS, TO REVISE THE MEANS OF ESTABLISHING DIVISIONS WITHIN THE VARIOUS CITY DEPARTMENTS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Establishes the Department of Field Operations and revises the means of establishing divisions within the various City departments.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 9, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.09.010: The departments of the City shall consist of the following:

[(A)] Building and Safety;

[(B)] City Attorney;

[(C)] Detention and Enforcement;

Field Operations;

[(D)] Finance and Business Services;

[(E)] Fire and Rescue;

[(F)] Human Resources;

[(G)] Information Technologies;

Leisure Services;

[(H)] Municipal Court;

[(I)] Neighborhood Services;

[(J)] Leisure Services;]

[(K)] Planning and Development;

[(L)] Public Works.

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 9, Sections 20 to 160, inclusive, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, are hereby repealed in their entirety.



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SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 9, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 20, reading as follows:

2.09.020: Each department of the City shall consist of such divisions and units as may be established from time to time by the City Manager.

SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

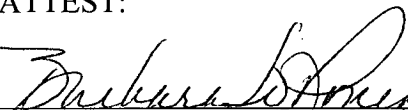

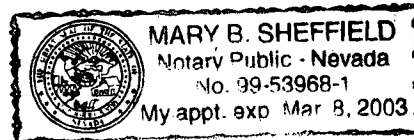
