4 AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES,
5 AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

6 Sponsored by: Councilman Lawrence Weekly Summary: Increases the salaries of the
7 Municipal Court judges.

8 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
9 AS FOLLOWS:

10 SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of
11 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **2.26.030:** (A) Except as is otherwise provided in [Subsection (B) of this Section and] Section
13 2.26.035, the salary of each Municipal Court Judge shall be [ninety-five thousand six hundred thirty-
14 three] one hundred thirteen thousand five hundred seventy-eight dollars per year, to take effect July
15 1, [1999.] 2002.

16 (B) The Municipal Judge who holds seniority in years of service in office, either
17 elected or appointed, is the Chief Judge.

18 SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 35, of the Municipal Code of the City of
19 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

20 **2.26.035:** The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges that are provided for in Section 2.26.030
21 shall automatically be increased:

22 (A) On the first day of July, [2000,] 2003, in the same proportion that the index
23 figure of the National Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for All Items, U.S. City
24 Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United States Department
25 of Labor, for March of [2000] 2003 has increased above [such] the index figure for March of [2000;]
26 2002; and

27 (B) On the first day of July in each year thereafter in the same proportion that [such]
28 the index figure for March of that year has increased above [such] the index figure for March of the



1 previous year.

2 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
3 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid
4 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
5 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
6 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
7 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
8 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
9 invalid or ineffective.

10 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
11 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
12 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Municipal Court judges.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of
Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.030: (A) Except as is otherwise provided in Subsection (B) of this Section and Section
2.26.035, the salary of each Municipal Court Judge shall be [ninety-five thousand six hundred thirty-
three] one hundred thirteen thousand five hundred seventy-eight dollars per year, to take effect July
1, [1999.] 2002.

(B) If the Clark County Board of Commissioners approves a salary increase before
the end of Fiscal Year 2003 for the justices of the Las Vegas Justice Court in an amount that exceeds
one hundred thirteen thousand five hundred seventy-eight dollars per year, the salary of each
Municipal Court Judge shall be in the same amount approved for the justices of the Las Vegas Justice
Court, but not to exceed one hundred twenty-nine thousand dollars per year. Any increase in salary
pursuant to this Subsection (B) shall become effective when the corresponding salary increase for the
justices of the Las Vegas Justice Court goes into effect.

~~[(B)]~~ (C) The Municipal Judge who holds seniority in years of service in office, either
elected or appointed, is the Chief Judge.

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 35, of the Municipal Code of the City of
Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.035: The salaries of the Municipal Court Judges that are provided for in Section 2.26.030
shall automatically be increased[:] as follows:

(A) [On] If the salaries have been increased during Fiscal Year 2003 in accordance with

1 Subsection (B) of Section 2.26.030, they shall be automatically be increased on the first day of July,
2 [2000,] 2004, in the same proportion that the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index for
3 All Urban Consumers for All Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the Bureau
4 of Labor Statistics, United States Department of Labor, for March of [2000] 2004 has increased above
5 [such] the index figure for March of [2000;] 2003; and thereafter in accordance with Subsection (C)
6 of this Section.

7 (B) If the salaries have not been increased before the end of Fiscal Year 2003 in
8 accordance with Subsection (B) of Section 2.26.030, they shall automatically be increased on the first
9 day of July, 2003, in the same proportion that the index figure of the National Consumer Price Index
10 for All Urban Consumers for All Items, U.S. City Average (1967 = 100) that is published by the
11 Bureau of Labor Statistics, United States Department of Labor, for March of 2003 has increased above
12 the index figure for March of 2002; and thereafter in accordance with Subsection (C) of this Section.

13 [(B)] (C) [On] In each year following an increase pursuant to Subsection (A) or
14 Subsection (B) of this Section, the salaries of the Municipal Court Judges shall automatically be
15 increased on the first day of July [in each year thereafter] of that year in the same proportion that
16 [such] the index figure for March of that year has increased above [such] the index figure for March
17 of the previous year.

18 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
19 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid
20 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
21 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
22 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
23 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
24 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
25 invalid or ineffective.

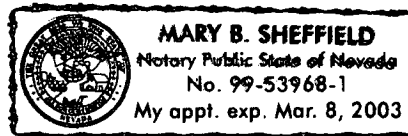

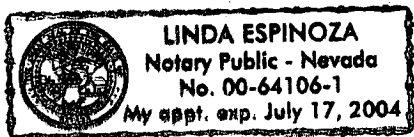
