Ordinance No. 3693

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PAWNBROKER LICENSES; AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 60, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, AND SECTIONS 6 AND 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 3675 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 16, 1992, BY EXEMPTING FROM THE OPERATION OF SAID SECTIONS QUALIFIED PAWNBROKER LICENSE APPLICANTS WHO SUBMITTED COMPLETE AND ACCEPTABLE LICENSE APPLICATIONS PRIOR TO AUGUST 20, 1992; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Amends Sections 6 and 8 of Ordinance 3675 by exempting from the operation thereof qualified pawnbroker licenses applicants who submitted complete and acceptable license applications prior to August 20, 1992.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 60, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, and Section 6 of Ordinance No. 3675 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, adopted September 16, 1992, are hereby amended so that SECTION 6 shall read as follows:

Section 6: [The City Council may, within twelve months of the effective date of this Ordinance, grant one new pawnbroker license.]

The City Council:

(A) May grant pawnbroker licenses to all qualified applicants whose complete and acceptable license applications were pending prior to August 20, 1992; and

(B) May, other than as provided in Subsection A of this Section, within twelve months of August 20, 1992, grant one additional pawnbroker license pursuant to the procedure set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 60, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, and SECTION 8 of

1 Ordinance No. 3675 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, adopted Sep-
2 tember 16, 1992, are hereby amended so that SECTION 8 shall read
3 as follows:

4 Section 8:

5 (A) Other than licenses granted to qualified applicants
6 whose complete and acceptable license applications were
7 pending prior to August 20, 1992, [All] all pawnbroker licen-
8 ses granted after the effective date of this Ordinance shall
9 be granted [in accordance with] pursuant to the procedure set
10 forth in this Section.

11 (B) For a license that the City Council may grant:

12 (1) Within twelve months of the effective date of
13 this Ordinance, the Director shall:

14 (a) Retain, unless withdrawn by an applicant,
15 all applications pending on the effective date of this
16 Ordinance; and

17 (b) Accept applications until, but not later
18 than, the conclusion of business on the thirtieth day
19 following the effective date of this Ordinance.

20 (2) In respect to a population increase
21 allowing the issuance of a new pawnbroker license, the
22 Director shall accept applications for a period of thirty
23 days beginning on the first day of April, or as soon
24 thereafter as practicable, of the year in which the governor
25 certifies that the population has achieved or exceeds an
26 increase allowing issuance of a pawnbroker license.

27 (C) An applicant may submit only one application for
28 each available license.

29 (D) If an applicant submits more than one application
30 or attempts to submit multiple applications on one applica-
31 tion form, all such multiple applications shall be construed
32 collectively as one application.

1 (E) The Director shall assign a number to all applica-
2 tions.

3 (F) Not more than fifteen calendar days after the
4 Director has ceased accepting applications, he shall:

5 (1) Conduct in public a random drawing of all of
6 the numbers assigned to applications to establish, in the
7 order drawn, a list of applicants' names and a rank of
8 priority of eligibility of applicants for the pawnbroker
9 license.

10 (2) Make the list of names and rank of priority of
11 eligibility of all applicants available to the public.

12 (3) Retain the list of applicants' names and rank
13 of priority of eligibility, which list and rank of priority
14 will expire at the close of business on the day the
15 pawnbroker license is granted.

16 (G) If an applicant becomes eligible to apply for the
17 pawnbroker license, he must, within six months of his selec-
18 tion or notification, complete the licensing process, which
19 includes without limitation:

20 (1) Fulfilling all business licensing requirements
21 of this Code;

22 (2) Meeting all zoning requirements applicable to
23 his prospective business location;

24 (3) Being found suitable for a pawnbroker license;
25 and

26 (4) Being approved for licensing by the City
27 Council.

28 (H) If an applicant:

29 (1) Does not complete the licensing process within
30 six months, his application will automatically expire, and
31 the Director shall notify the next applicant on the list in
32 the rank of priority of eligibility to begin the licensing

process.

(2) Completes the licensing process, but is denied a license, the Director shall notify the next applicant on the list in the rank of priority of eligibility to begin the licensing process.

(3) Such selection, notification and licensing process shall continue until a pawnbroker license is granted.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
