Ordinance No. 3314

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LAS VEGAS MUNICIPAL COURT; AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 26, SECTION 40, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO INCREASE FROM \$50.00 PER SESSION TO \$75.00 PER SESSION THE COMPENSATION FOR THE ALTERNATE MUNICIPAL JUDGES; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Increases compensation for alternate municipal judges from \$50.00 to \$75.00 per session

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 40, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.26.40: (A) Alternate municipal judges in sufficient numbers shall be appointed yearly by the mayor.

(B) An alternate judge shall possess the same qualifications required of the elected municipal court judges and shall receive as compensation the sum of [thirty] seventy-five dollars for each morning, afternoon or evening session of the Court at which he presides. [The compensation of an alternate judge shall increase to the sum of fifty dollars for each session; this increase to take effect for yearly appointments beginning on or after January 1, 1981.]

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of

1 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
2 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
3 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
4 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,
5 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-
6 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
7 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

8 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-
9 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
10 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
11 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

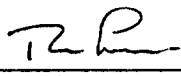
1 The above and foregoing ordinance was first proposed

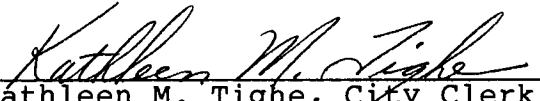

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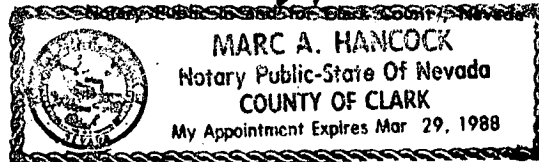
