ORDINANCE No. 2295

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO GAMING; ALLOWING FOR THE ISSUANCE BY THE DIRECTOR OF BUSINESS ACTIVITY OF A PERMIT FOR THE TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF GAMES UPON LICENSED PREMISES FOR A HOLIDAY OR SPECIAL EVENT; PROVIDING FOR A PERMIT FEE; REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE PERMIT; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

Summay: Allows for the temporary placement of additional games by a gaming licensee for a holiday or special event.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS,
NEVADA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to add a new section to read as follows:

5-17-8.5 (A) Any licensee who has acquired a "holiday or special event" permit from the State to add additional games to the licensed premises during an anticipated temporary period of increased tourist activity, may apply to the Director for a holiday or special event permit from the City. The application must be made on a form acceptable to the Director and filed at least three (3) days prior to the date the games are to be added.

(B) If the permit is approved by the Director he shall specify on the permit the number and type of games approved and the time period for which they are permitted. The number of games and the time permitted shall not exceed that which has been approved by the State and in no case shall the time period exceed seven (7) days. The licensee shall not exceed or deviate from the number and types of games allowed under the permit or allow the games to remain on the premises beyond the time permitted.

1 (C) The licensee must pay in advance a permit fee equal
2 to one sixth of the regular semi-annual license fee for each
3 game permitted for a holiday or special event. The licensee
4 must also pay the regular quarterly convention authority tax
5 imposed by LVC Title V, Chapter 2.

6 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
7 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
8 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
9 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such deci-
10 sion shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
11 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
12 Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
13 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
14 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-
15 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections,
16 subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
17 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.
