AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO GAMING; EXPANDING THE SPECIAL GAMING DISTRICT ALONG OWENS AVENUE TO ALLOW NONRESTRICTED GAMING TO EXTEND FROM "H" STREET TO HIGHLAND AVENUE.

Commissioner Roy Woofter	Extends the special gaming district along Owens Avenue from "H" Street to Highland Avenue.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS,
NEVADA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 17, Section 6 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-17-6 (A) No gaming shall be conducted, maintained or operated in the City except as allowed within the following specified districts:

(1) The area Bounded by the east side of Main Street, the south side of Stewart Avenue, the west side of 3rd Street and the north side of Carson Avenue.

(2) The frontage on both sides of West Jackson Avenue between North "D" Street and North "G" Street and the frontage on both sides of Owens Avenue between "H" Street and ["J" Street.] Highland Avenue.

(B) Notwithstanding Subsection (A) of this Section, the following nonrestricted gaming may be permitted by the Board outside said districts:

(1) At those locations which have been approved by the Board for a nonrestricted license prior to the adoption of this ordinance.

(2) In hotels having at least 100 guest rooms available to the public.

(C) Notwithstanding Subsection (A) of this Section, slot machines only may be permitted by the Board outside said districts upon premises whereon there is conducted a licensed

- 1 business whose principle activity is other than gaming, if:
- 2 (1) The business operates under a general on-sale or a
- 3 general on-off-sale alcoholic beverage license with a
- 4 restaurant connected therewith having full kitchen
- 5 facilities and all located within a free-standing
- 6 building having in excess of 3,000 square feet of usable
- 7 floor space under one roof, provided that such license
- 8 is limited to not more than 35 slot machines;
- 9 (2) The licensed business premises have in excess of 9,000
- 10 square feet of usable floor space under one roof and the
- 11 slot machines are under the supervision of a change
- 12 attendant at all times. Provided however that such
- 13 licenses are limited to not more than 35 slot machines;
- 14 (3) The gaming license is limited to not more than 15 slot
- 15 machines.

16 (D) Nothing contained in this Section shall be construed to

17 require the issuance of a gaming license to any applicant because

18 of location, structure involved or nature of any allied business.

19 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,

20 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part

21 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid

22 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such deci-

23 sion shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the

24 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
