ORDINANCE NO. 5375

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING CODE PROVISIONS RELATING TO WHEEL STOPS IN PARKING AREAS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Proposed by: Robert S. Genzer,

Summary: Amends the Zoning Code provisions
relating to wheel stops in parking areas.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Subsection 19A.10.010(K)(9) of the Zoning Code of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended to read as follows:

9. Wheel Stops/Curbing

Concrete wheel stops or curbing at least six inches high and six inches wide shall be provided to prevent vehicles overhanging abutting sidewalks, properties or public rights-of-way, to protect landscaped areas and to protect adjacent properties. Such wheel stops or curbing shall be located at least three feet from any adjacent wall, fence, property line, walkway or structure where parking [and] or drive aisles are located. Wheel stops or curbing shall not be required to protect a sidewalk or walkway around the perimeter of a building if the sidewalk or walkway is at least seven feet wide.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a

1 misdemeanor, the doing of such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
2 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
3 \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of such
4 fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

5 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
6 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
7 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
