11 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
12 AS FOLLOWS:

13 SECTION 1: Section 4 of Ordinance No. 5149 of the City of Las Vegas is hereby
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 4: (A) There shall be a Director of the Review Board, who shall be
16 appointed by the County Manager, in consultation with the City Manager, with the advice and consent
17 of the Board of County Commissioners and the Council, [, and who shall serve] The term of the
18 Director's service shall be at the pleasure of the County Manager and the City Manager, with the
19 advice and consent of the Board of County Commissioners and the Council.

20 (B) The County and the City may, upon mutual agreement, provide such funding,
21 staffing, legal counsel and other resources as they determine, according to their sole discretion, to be
22 necessary for the performance of the functions of the Director and the Review Board. Neither the
23 Director, the Review Board, nor any panel of the Review Board shall incur any expense for which
24 funding has not been approved by the City and the County.

25 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
26 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid
27 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
28 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,

1 invalid or ineffective.

2 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
3 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
4 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
