

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE DRINKING OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE OR IN VEHICLES IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, AND PROVIDING A PUNISHMENT THEREFOR.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

Section 1. For the purposes of this ordinance a "public place" shall be defined to be any street, alley, sidewalk, thoroughfare, vacant lot, school premises, or entrance of any store, hotel, or other public building, in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada.

Section 2. Any person who shall drink any intoxicating liquor in any public place as herein defined, or in any vehicle in any public place, in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or imprisoned in the city jail for a period not exceeding fifty (50) days, or shall be punished by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication and passage.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to have this ordinance published in the Las Vegas Review-Journal a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, once a week for a period of two weeks.

Proposed, read aloud in full, and adopted, this 15th day of November 1934, by the following vote: Commissioners Arnett Martelli - German - Sloan and His Honor the Mayor voting aye. Noes none.
