ORDINANCE NO. 3111

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 12, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY REPEALING SECTION 10 IN ITS ENTIRETY PERTAINING TO THE VACCINATION OF ALL WARMBLOODED ANIMALS REACHING THE AGE OF THREE (3) MONTHS; ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 10 IN LIEU THEREOF WHICH IMPOSES THE VACCINATION REQUIREMENT UPON THE OWNER, KEEPER, HARBORER OR POSSESSOR OF DOGS OR CATS REACHING THE AGE OF THREE (3) MONTHS AND UPON DOGS OR CATS HAVING ALREADY REACHED SUCH AGE IF THE ANIMAL HAS NOT BEEN PREVIOUSLY VACCINATED; REQUIRING THAT DOGS OR CATS VACCINATED BETWEEN THE AGE OF THREE (3) MONTHS AND TWELVE (12) MONTHS BE VACCINATED ONE YEAR LATER REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SAID ANIMAL WAS VACCINATED WITHIN THE CITY OR IN A JURISDICTION OTHER THAN THE CITY; EXEMPTING DOGS OR CATS VACCINATED IN A JURISDICTION OTHER THAN THE CITY FROM THE REVACCINATION REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN SECTION 7.12.30 FOR CERTAIN PERIODS STATED THEREIN; REPEALING SECTION 30 IN ITS ENTIRETY PERTAINING TO THE REVACCINATION REQUIREMENTS OF WARMBLOODED ANIMALS; ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 30 IN LIEU THEREOF REQUIRING THAT DOGS VACCINATED BETWEEN THE AGE OF THREE (3) MONTHS AND TWELVE (12) MONTHS SHALL BE VACCINATED ONE (1) YEAR LATER AND SUBSEQUENTLY EVERY TWO (2) YEARS THEREAFTER AND THAT CATS BE REVACCINATED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: This bill limits the requirement of rabies vaccination to dogs and cats, instead of all warmblooded animals; credits vaccinations in jurisdictions other than the City for the period of time stated therein; imposes different revaccination requirements upon dogs and cats.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 7, Chapter 12, Sections 10 and 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2: Title 7, Chapter 12, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding a new section, to be designated as Section 10, reading as follows:

7.12.010 (A) Requirement of Vaccination. Any person owning, keeping, harboring or possessing a dog or cat within the City shall cause said animal to be

1 vaccinated with a rabies vaccine within thirty (30)
2 days after the animal reaches the age of three (3)
3 months. Any person subsequently owning, keeping,
4 harboring or possessing an animal within the City
5 which has already reached the age of three (3)
6 months shall cause said animal to be vaccinated
7 with a rabies vaccine within thirty (30) days after
8 the dog or cat came into the possession or under
9 the control of that person, if the animal has not
10 been previously vaccinated for rabies.

11 (B) Vaccinations Outside of the City. Any person owning,
12 keeping, harboring or possessing a dog or cat which
13 was initially vaccinated for rabies in a jurisdic-
14 tion other than the City while the animal was
15 between the ages of three (3) months and twelve
16 (12) months shall cause that dog or cat to be
17 vaccinated one year after that vaccination in
18 accordance with the requirements of Section
19 7.12.030.

20 Any person owning, keeping, harboring or possessing
21 a dog or cat which was vaccinated for rabies in a
22 jurisdiction other than the City after the animal
23 reached the age of twelve (12) months is temporarily
24 exempt from the requirement of having the animal
25 revaccinated, pursuant to Section 7.12.030, for
26 the effective period of the vaccine which was used
27 in that vaccination, as stated by the manufacturer
28 of the vaccine, measured from the date of such
29 vaccination; provided, however, that no such
30 animal will be exempt from the requirements of
31 revaccination contained in Section 7.12.030 for
32 more than two years, in the case of dogs, and one

1 year, in the case of cats, after the date of such
2 vaccination, regardless of the effective period
3 of the vaccine. Any vaccination of a dog or cat
4 for rabies which has occurred in a jurisdiction
5 other than the City (i) must have been by a
6 person licensed to practice veterinary medicine
7 within that jurisdiction, and (ii) must be evidenced
8 by a Certificate of Vaccination which contains the
9 information required in Section 7.12.050, in order
10 for the person owning, keeping, harboring or
11 possessing the dog or cat to be entitled to the
12 temporary exemption provided for herein.

13 (C) An exemption from the requirements of this section
14 shall be allowed for dogs and cats while being
15 boarded by a commercial kennel if such animals are
16 separately confined.

17 SECTION 3: Title 7, Chapter 12 of the Municipal Code
18 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended
19 by adding a new section, to be designated as Section 30, reading
20 as follows:

21 7.12.030 (A) Dogs. Every person owning, keeping, harboring or
22 possessing a dog within the City which was initially
23 vaccinated for rabies between the ages of three
24 (3) months and twelve (12) months shall be re-
25 vaccinated one year after the initial vaccination,
26 and thereafter shall be revaccinated every two (2)
27 years, with a vaccine effective for a minimum of
28 two years.

29 (B) Cats. Every person owning, keeping, harboring or
30 possessing a cat within the City shall be re-
31 vaccinated on an annual basis with a vaccine
32 effective for a minimum of one year.

1 SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
3 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
4 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
5 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
6 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
7 City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares
8 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
9 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of
10 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
11 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
12 tional, invalid or ineffective.

13 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
14 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
15 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
16 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 12, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY REPEALING SECTION 10 IN ITS ENTIRETY PERTAINING TO THE VACCINATION OF ALL WARMBLOODED ANIMALS REACHING THE AGE OF THREE (3) MONTHS; ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 10 IN LIEU THEREOF WHICH IMPOSES THE VACCINATION REQUIREMENT UPON THE OWNER, KEEPER, HARBORER OR POSSESSOR OF DOGS OR CATS REACHING THE AGE OF FOUR (4) MONTHS AND UPON DOGS OR CATS HAVING ALREADY REACHED SUCH AGE IF THE ANIMAL HAS NOT BEEN PREVIOUSLY VACCINATED; REQUIRING THAT DOGS OR CATS VACCINATED BETWEEN THE AGE OF FOUR (4) MONTHS AND TWELVE (12) MONTHS BE VACCINATED ONE YEAR LATER REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SAID ANIMAL WAS VACCINATED WITHIN THE CITY OR IN A JURISDICTION OTHER THAN THE CITY; EXEMPTING DOGS OR CATS VACCINATED IN A JURISDICTION OTHER THAN THE CITY FROM THE REVACCINATION REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN SECTION 7.12.30 FOR CERTAIN PERIODS STATED THEREIN; REPEALING SECTION 30 IN ITS ENTIRETY PERTAINING TO THE REVACCINATION REQUIREMENTS OF WARMBLOODED ANIMALS; ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 30 IN LIEU THEREOF REQUIRING THAT DOGS VACCINATED BETWEEN THE AGE OF FOUR (4) MONTHS AND TWELVE (12) MONTHS SHALL BE VACCINATED ONE (1) YEAR LATER AND SUBSEQUENTLY EVERY TWO (2) YEARS THEREAFTER AND THAT CATS BE REVACCINATED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

7.12.010 (A) Requirement of Vaccination. Any person owning, keeping, harboring or possessing a dog or cat within the City shall cause said animal to be

1 vaccinated with a rabies vaccine within thirty (30)
2 days after the animal reaches the age of four (4)
3 months. Any person subsequently owning, keeping,
4 harboring or possessing an animal within the City
5 which has already reached the age of four (4)
6 months shall cause said animal to be vaccinated
7 with a rabies vaccine within thirty (30) days after
8 the dog or cat came into the possession or under
9 the control of that person, if the animal has not
10 been previously vaccinated for rabies.

11 (B) Vaccinations Outside of the City. Any person owning,
12 keeping, harboring or possessing a dog or cat which
13 was initially vaccinated for rabies in a jurisdic-
14 tion other than the City while the animal was
15 between the ages of four (4) months and twelve
16 (12) months shall cause that dog or cat to be
17 vaccinated one year after that vaccination in
18 accordance with the requirements of Section
19 7.12.030.

20 Any person owning, keeping, harboring or possessing
21 a dog or cat which was vaccinated for rabies in a
22 jurisdiction other than the City after the animal
23 reached the age of twelve (12) months is temporarily
24 exempt from the requirement of having the animal
25 revaccinated, pursuant to Section 7.12.030, for
26 the effective period of the vaccine which was used
27 in that vaccination, as stated by the manufacturer
28 of the vaccine, measured from the date of such
29 vaccination; provided, however, that no such
30 animal will be exempt from the requirements of
31 revaccination contained in Section 7.12.030 for
32 more than two years, in the case of dogs, and one

1 year, in the case of cats, after the date of such

- 29 (B) Cats. Every person owning, keeping, harboring or
30 possessing a cat within the City shall be re-
31 vaccinated on an annual basis with a vaccine
32 effective for a minimum of one year.

1 SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
3 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
4 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
5 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
6 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
7 City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares
8 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
9 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of

13 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,

SECTION 2: Title 7, Chapter 12 is hereby amended by
adding a new Section 010 to read as follows:

7.12.010 Any person owning or possessing a dog or cat which
has not been vaccinated after reaching the age of
three (3) months shall cause said animal to be vaccinated
with a vaccine licensed by the United States Department
of Agriculture for use in said animal within thirty (30)
days of (i) the dog or cat attaining said age, or (ii)
if the animal has already attained said age and there
is no certificate of vaccination indicating that the
animal has been vaccinated, then within thirty (30)
days of said person having obtained ownership or possession
of said animal. The certificate of vaccination shall be
issued only by a person who has been licensed by this
State to practice veterinary medicine. A certificate of
rabies vaccination issued in another state or foreign

1 country will be recognized as in compliance with the
2 requirements of this section if (i) the vaccination
3 has been administered by a person licensed to practice
4 veterinary medicine within the state or foreign country,
5 and (ii) the vaccination meets the requirements of this
6 section. The requirements of vaccination shall not
7 apply to any person who has obtained an exemption from
8 the Animal Regulation Officer. Any dog vaccinated between
9 the age of three (3) and twelve (12) months shall be
10 vaccinated one year later and thereafter every two years
11 with a vaccine effective for a two year period. All
12 cats shall be vaccinated on an annual basis.
13 The provisions of this section do not apply to
14 commercial kennels.

Summary: Repeals existing section imposing the rabies vaccination upon all warmblooded animals and inserts a new section requiring only the vaccination of dogs and cats.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 7, Chapter 12, Section 010 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: Title 7, Chapter 12 is hereby amended by adding a new Section 010 to read as follows:

7.12.010 Any person owning or possessing a dog or cat which has not been vaccinated after reaching the age of three (3) months shall cause said animal to be vaccinated with a vaccine licensed by the United States Department of Agriculture for use in said animal within thirty (30) days of (i) the dog or cat attaining said age, or (ii) if the animal has already attained said age and there is no certificate of vaccination indicating that the animal has been vaccinated, then within thirty (30) days of said person having obtained ownership or possession of said animal. The certificate of vaccination shall be issued only by the Animal Regulation Officer or a person who has been licensed by this State, or by any other state or foreign government to practice veterinary medicine.

1 The requirements of vaccination shall not apply to any
2 person who has obtained an exemption from the Animal
3 Regulation Officer. Any dog vaccinated between the age
4 of three (3) and twelve (12) months shall be vaccinated
5 one year later and thereafter every two years with a
6 vaccine effective for a two year period. All cats
7 shall be vaccinated on an annual basis.

8 The provisions of this section do not apply to
9 commercial kennels.

10 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
11 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
12 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
13 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
14 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
15 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
