4 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PUBLIC PARKS; AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER
5 36, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983
6 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION, DESIGNATED SECTION 55,
7 ESTABLISHING UNIFORM HOURS DURING WHICH THE PUBLIC PARKS SHALL BE
8 OPEN; AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 36, SECTION 70, OF SAID MUNICIPAL
9 CODE TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO PARK A
10 MOTOR VEHICLE IN A PARKING LOT WHICH IS LOCATED IN OR ADJACENT TO
11 A PUBLIC PARK AT HOURS DURING WHICH SUCH PARK IS CLOSED; PROVIDING
12 OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
13 THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF
14 ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

15 Sponsored by: Summary: Establishes uniform hours
16 Councilman Bob Nolen during which the City parks are
17 open to the public and prohibits
18 the parking of motor vehicles in
19 the parking lots which are located
20 in or adjacent to the City parks.

21 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES
22 HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

23 SECTION 1: Title 13, Chapter 36, of the Municipal Code
24 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended
25 by adding thereto a new section, to be designated as Section 55,
26 reading as follows:

27 13.36.055: Except when action by the City Manager has established
28 different hours of closure of certain City parks pursu-
29 ant to LVMC Section 13.36.050, all City parks shall be
30 open to the public between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and
31 9:00 p.m. and during such other hours as may be appro-
32 priate to accommodate events or activities which are
sponsored by the Department of Recreation and Leisure
Activities.

Section 2: Title 13, Chapter 36, Section 70, of the
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

13.36.070: It is unlawful for any person to go upon [or], remain
in or stop, stand or park any motor vehicle in any park,

1 including any parking lot therein or any publically
2 maintained parking lot immediately adjacent thereto,
3 during the time that it is closed when signs have been
4 posted in the park which specify the hours of closure.

5 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
6 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
7 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
8 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
9 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
10 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The City
11 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it
12 would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,
13 sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that
14 any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
15 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid
16 or ineffective.

17 SECTION 4: Whenever in this ordinance any act is pro-
18 hibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or
19 a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act
20 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
21 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such
22 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
23 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be
24 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
25 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of
26 such fine and imprisonment. Any date of any violation of this
27 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

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1 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
2 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
3 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
4 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
