ORDINANCE NO. 3118

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SENIOR CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD; AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 46, SECTIONS 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 AND 70, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO REQUIRE A HIATUS IN MEMBERSHIP ON THE BOARD OF AT LEAST ONE YEAR AFTER AN APPOINTIVE MEMBER'S SERVICE OF TWO CONSECUTIVE TERMS; TO CHANGE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR HONORARY MEMBERS; TO ESTABLISH AN EMERITUS MEMBERSHIP STATUS; TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE BOARD BY THE CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 10 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.46.10: There is created a Senior Citizens' Advisory Board consisting of:

(A) The Senior Citizens' C Coordinating Officer of the City appointed by the Mayor, who shall be accorded all rights and responsibilities as any member appointed pursuant to Subsection (D) of this Section;

(B) One member appointed by the [Board of City Commissioners] City Council from among its number, who shall be accorded all rights and responsibilities as any member appointed pursuant to Subsection

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(D) of this Section;

(C) One member appointed by the Board of County Commissioners from among its number, who shall be accorded all rights and responsibilities as any member appointed pursuant to Subsection (D) of this Section;

(D) Eleven appointive members, who shall:

(1) Each be a registered voter in Clark County,

(2) Each be appointed by the [Board of City Commissioners] City Council,

[(2)] (3) Serve for a period of three years, unless such [memeber] member is appointed to fill a vacancy which has occurred otherwise than through the expiration of the term, in which case such member shall serve until the expiration of the unexpired term,

[(3)] (4) Submit[, if they so desire,] to the City Council recommendations for appointments and reappointments to the Advisory Board [to the Board of Commissioners of the City,]; provided, however, that such appointments shall be made in such a manner as to effect the intent of this provision that at all times, except in cases of vacancies, a majority of the members who serve on the Advisory Board pursuant to Subsections (A) to (D), inclusive, of this Section shall be residents of the City,

[(4)] (5) Be eligible [for reappointment at the expiration of their term,] to serve a maximum of two consecutive terms and become eligible for reappointment after a one year hiatus from the board,

1 (6) Have their unexpired terms, if they are serving
2 unexpired terms, counted as full terms if
3 their periods of service are two years or more,

4 [(5)] (7) Be eligible to vote on any matter subject to
5 vote by the Board;

6 (E) Honorary members, who shall:

7 (1) Be chosen from the ranks of the business and
8 professional community and be persons who
9 are interested in the Las Vegas Senior
10 Citizens' Centers and senior affairs and who
11 will work for and support the centers'
12 activities in community wide involvements,

13 [(1)] (2) Be [recommended by the Advisory Board and
14 submitted and] approved for appointment by
15 the [Board of Commissioners of the City,]
16 City Council,

17 [(2) Number as many as the Board of Commissioners,
18 in its discretion, shall choose,]

19 (3) Be entitled to participate in the discussion
20 of any issue being considered by the Board,
21 but shall not be entitled to vote on any
22 matter subject to vote by the Board,

23 (4) Serve for a term of three years; [and be
24 eligible for reappointment;]

25 (F) Ex officio member, who shall:

26 (1) Be the Director of the Las Vegas Senior
27 Citizens' Center,

28 (2) Attend all meetings of the Board but not be
29 entitled to vote on any matter subject to
30 vote by the Board[.]; and

31 (G) Emeritus Members, who shall:

32 (1) Be senior former members of the Senior

1 Citizens' Advisory Board who have served at
2 least two terms and who have been recommended
3 for emeritus status by a nominating
4 committee of the Board,

5 (2) Be entitled to participate in the discussion
6 of any issue being considered by the Board,
7 but shall not be entitled to vote on any
8 matter subject to vote by the Board.

9 SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 20 of the
10 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 2.46.20: (A) The officers of the Senior Citizens' Advisory
13 Board shall be a Chairman, a Vice Chairman and a
14 Secretary.

15 (B) Within [fifteen] thirty (30) days after the appoint-
16 ment of the Board, the members shall meet in regular
17 session and select from their members the Chairman,
18 Vice Chairman, and Secretary.

19 (C) The duties of the officers of the Board shall
20 respectively be as are usually carried by such
21 officers.

22 (D) The officers shall hold office for one year, or
23 until their successors are selected.

24 SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 30 of the
25 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
26 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 2.46.030: The Board shall adopt rules, [and] regulations, and
28 bylaws, not inconsistent with this Chapter, to govern
29 [procedures and] itself, its members, and its affairs.
30 The Board shall, by vote, set a time for regular
31 meetings, which shall be held at least once a month,
32 and shall determine the manner in which special

1 meetings may be called, held, and the notice given.

2 The Nevada Open Meeting Law shall take precedence in
3 these matters.

4 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 40 of the
5 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 2.46.040: A majority of the regular members shall constitute a
8 quorum for all purposes. The regular members are
9 the aggregate of the members who are appointed pursu-
10 ant to Subsections (A) to (D), inclusive, of Section 20
11 of this Chapter.

12 SECTION 5: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 50 of the
13 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition
14 is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 2.46.050: [Members] Each member of the Senior Citizens' Advisory
16 Board must attend seventy-five percent of all regular
17 meetings[,] of the Board on an annual basis, of which
18 [they have] he or she has notice, excluding excused
19 absences[.] as defined in the bylaws. Failure to
20 attend seventy-five percent of such meetings or failure
21 to attend three consecutive regular meetings, excluding
22 excused absences as defined in the bylaws, shall con-
23 stitute sufficient grounds for the Advisory Board
24 [of Commissioners, at its discretion, to remove] to
25 recommend to the City Council that the said member be
26 removed and [declare] the position declared vacant.

27 SECTION 6: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 60 of the
28 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition is
29 hereby amended to read as follows:

30 2.46.60: Minutes of the meetings of the Senior Citizens'
31 Advisory Board shall:

32 (A) Be [be] filed with the City Clerk within thirty

1 days following such meetings[.];

2 (B) Be sent to all members of the Senior Citizens'
3 Advisory Board, to the City Council and to other
4 appropriate persons as determined by the City Clerk.

5 SECTION 7: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 70 of the
6 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition
7 is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 2.46.070: The duties of the Senior Citizens' Advisory Board
9 shall be:

8 to the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Centers and the
9 Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Advisory Board, shall
10 apply in toto and without exception to all senior
11 centers established by the City of Las Vegas.

12 SECTION 8: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
13 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
14 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
15 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
16 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
17 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The City
18 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that
19 it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
20 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of
21 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
22 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
23 tional, invalid or ineffective.

24 SECTION 9: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
25 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs

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1 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
2 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 10 of the
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

2.46.10: There is created a Senior Citizens' Advisory Board
consisting of:

(A) The Senior Citizens' Coordinating Officer of the
City appointed by the Mayor, who shall be accorded
all rights and responsibilities as any member
appointed pursuant to Subsection [(D)] (E) of this
Section;

(B) One member appointed by the [Board of City
Commissioners] City Council from among its number,
who shall be accorded all rights and responsibilities
as any member appointed pursuant to Subsection

1 [(D)] (E) of this Section;

2 (C) One member appointed by the Board of County
3 Commissioners from among its number, who shall be
4 accorded all rights and responsibilities as any
5 member appointed pursuant to Subsection [(D)] (E)
6 of this Section;

7 (D) The Director of the Las Vegas Senior Citizens'
8 Centers, who shall attend all meetings of the
9 Board and who shall be accorded all rights and
10 responsibilities as any member appointed pursuant
11 to Subsection (E) of this Section;

12 (E) Eleven appointive members, who shall:

13 (1) Each be a registered voter in Clark County,

14 (2) Each be appointed by the [Board of City
15 Commissioners] City Council, from names
16 submitted only through the Senior Citizens'
17 Advisory Board,

18 [(2)] (3) Serve for a period of three years, unless such
19 [memeber] member is appointed to fill a
20 vacancy which has occurred otherwise than
21 through the expiration of the term, in which
22 case such member shall serve until the expira-
23 tion of the unexpired term,

24 [(3)] (4) Submit[, if they so desire,] to the City
25 Council recommendations for appointments and
26 reappointments to the Advisory Board [to the
27 Board of Commissioners of the City,]; provided,
28 however, that such appointments shall be made
29 in such a manner as to effect the intent of
30 this provision that at all times, except in
31 cases of vacancies, a majority of the members
32 who serve on the Advisory Board pursuant to

1 subsections A to E, inclusive, of this Sec-
2 tion shall be residents of the City.

3 [(4)] (5) Be eligible [for reappointment at the expira-
4 tion of their term,] to serve a maximum of two
5 consecutive terms and become eligible for
6 reappointment after a one year hiatus from
7 the board,

8 (6) Have their unexpired terms, if they are serving
9 unexpired terms, counted as full terms if
10 their periods of service are two years or more.

11 [(5)] (7) Be eligible to vote on any matter subject to
12 vote by the Board;

13 [(E)] (F) Honorary members, who shall:

14 (1) Be chosen from the ranks of the business and
15 professional community and be persons who
16 are interested in the Las Vegas Senior
17 Citizens' Centers and senior affairs and who
18 will work for and support the centers'
19 activities in community wide involvements,

20 [(1)] (2) Be recommended [by] through the Advisory
21 Board only and submitted and approved for
22 appointment by the [Board of Commissioners
23 of the City,] City Council.

24 [(2) Number as many as the Board of Commissioners,
25 in its discretion, shall choose,]

26 (3) Be entitled to participate in the discussion
27 of any issue being considered by the Board,
28 but shall not be entitled to vote on any
29 matter subject to vote by the Board,

30 (4) Serve for a term of three years; [and be
31 eligible for reappointment;]

32 [(F) Ex officio member, who shall:

1 (1) Be the Director of the Las Vegas Senior
2 Citizens' Center,

3 (2) Attend all meetings of the Board but not be
4 entitled to vote on any matter subject to
5 vote by the Board.]

6 (G) Emeritus Members, who shall;

7 (1) Be senior former members of the Senior
8 Citizens' Advisory Board who have served at
9 least two terms and who have been recommended
10 for emeritus status by the nominating
11 committee of the Board,

12 (2) Be entitled to participate in the discussion
13 of any issue being considered by the Board,
14 but shall not be entitled to vote on any
15 matter subject to vote by the Board.

16 SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 20 of the
17 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
18 is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 2.46.20: (A) The officers of the Senior Citizens' Advisory
20 Board shall be a Chairman, a Vice Chairman and a
21 Secretary.

22 (B) Within [fifteen] thirty (30) days after the appoint-
23 ment of the Board, the members shall meet in regular
24 session and select from their members the Chairman,
25 Vice Chairman, and Secretary.

26 (C) The duties of the officers of the Board shall
27 respectively be as are usually carried by such
28 officers.

29 (D) The officers shall hold office for one year, or
30 until their successors are selected.

31 SECTION 3: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 30 of the
32 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,

1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 2.46.030: The Board shall adopt rules, [and] regulations, and
3 bylaws, not inconsistent with this Chapter, to govern
4 [procedures and] itself, its members, and its affairs.
5 The Board shall, by vote, set a time for regular
6 meetings, which shall be held at least once a month,
7 and shall determine the manner in which special
8 meetings may be called, held, and the notice given.
9 The Nevada Open Meeting Law shall take precedence in
10 these matters.

11 SECTION 4: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 40 of the
12 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 2.46.040: A majority of the regular members shall constitute a
15 quorum for all purposes. The regular members are
16 the aggregate of the members who are appointed pursu-
17 ant to Subsections (A) to (E), inclusive, of Section 20
18 of this Chapter.

19 SECTION 5: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 50 of the
20 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition
21 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 2.46.050: [Members] Each member of the Senior Citizens' Advisory
23 Board must attend seventy-five percent of all regular
24 meetings[,], of the Board on an annual basis, of which
25 [they have] he or she has notice, excluding excused
26 absences[.] as defined in the bylaws. Failure to
27 attend seventy-five percent of such meetings or failure
28 to attend three consecutive regular meetings, excluding
29 excused absences as defined in the bylaws, shall con-
30 stitute sufficient grounds for the Advisory Board
31 [of Commissioners, at its discretion, to remove] to
32 recommend to the City Council that the said member be

1 removed and [declare] the position declared vacant.

2 SECTION 6: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 60 of the
3 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition is
4 hereby amended to read as follows:

5 2.46.60: Minutes of the meetings of the Senior Citizens'

6 Advisory Board shall:

7 (A) Be [be] filed with the City Clerk within thirty
8 days following such meetings[.];

9 (B) Be sent to all members of the Senior Citizens'
10 Advisory Board, to the City Council and to other
11 appropriate persons as determined by the City Clerk.

12 SECTION 7: Title 2, Chapter 46, Section 70 of the
13 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition
14 is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 2.46.070: The duties of the Senior Citizens' Advisory Board
16 shall be:

17 (A) To act in [a recommending] an advisory capacity,
18 in cooperation with the Senior Citizens' Center
19 Director, to the [Board of Commissioners] City
20 Council and the City Manager on all matters per-
21 taining to the Las Vegas Senior Citizens'
22 Centers and to cooperate with the Director, the
23 City Council and with all other governmental
24 agencies, [and] civic groups and voluntary agencies
25 in the [advance] advancement of sound planning for
26 [such center;] services to older Americans;

27 (B) To [recommend to] advise the [Board of Commissioners,]
28 City Council and the City Manager in cooperation
29 with the Director, [of the Las Vegas Senior Citizens'
30 Center,] in writing, as to priorities for all
31 expenditures pertaining to the Las Vegas Senior

1 (C) [To aid in coordinating the services provided by
2 the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Center with programs
3 provided by other governmental agencies and other
4 voluntary organizations;

5 (D)] To [formulate] advise the Senior Citizens' Center
6 Director, the City Council and the City Manager on
7 formulating programs and activities to effectuate
8 the purpose for which the Las Vegas Senior Citizens
9 Centers were [was] created;

10 [(E) To assist in the functions of the Las Vegas
11 Senior Citizens' Center Director with the public;

12 (F)] (D) To report [their] its activities annually through
13 the Director to the City Manager[.];

14 (E) Each of the provisions of this Chapter, pertaining
15 to the Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Centers and the
16 Las Vegas Senior Citizens' Advisory Board, shall
17 apply in toto and without exception to all senior
18 centers established by the City of Las Vegas.

19 SECTION 8: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
20 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
21 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
22 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
23 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
24 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The City
25 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that
26 it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
27 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of
28 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
29 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
30 tional, invalid or ineffective.

31 SECTION 9: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
32 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs

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contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
