6 VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR
7 ANY PERSON WILFULLY TO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE LAWFUL ORDER OF
8 OFFICIALS OF THE TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION; AMENDING TITLE 11,
9 CHAPTER 8, SECTION 30, OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE TO AUTHORIZE
10 OFFICIALS OF THE TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION TO ISSUE TRAFFIC
11 CITATIONS; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO;
12 PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL
13 ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

18 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES
19 HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

20 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 6, Section 30, of the
21 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
22 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 11.06.030: No person shall wilfully fail or refuse to comply
24 with any lawful order or direction of a Police Officer
25 [or], Department of Fire Services official[.] or
26 Traffic Engineering Division Official.

27 SECTION 2: Title 11, Chapter 8, Section 30, of the
28 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition,
29 is hereby amended to read as follows:

30 11.08.030: (A) Whenever any person is halted by a peace officer
31 for any violation of this Title and is not required
32 to be taken before a magistrate, the person shall,
in the discretion of the peace officer, either be
given a traffic citation or be taken without
unnecessary delay before a magistrate.

(B) Whenever any person is halted by an official of
the Traffic Engineering Division for a violation

1 of this Title and is not required to be taken
2 before a magistrate, the person shall be given
3 a traffic citation.

4 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
5 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part
6 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid
7 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
8 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
9 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The City
10 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that
11 it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
12 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of
13 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
14 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
15 tional, invalid or ineffective.

16 SECTION 4: Whenever in this ordinance any act is pro-
17 hibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or
18 a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act
19 is required or the failure to do any act is made or declared to
20 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of any such
21 prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall
22 constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be
23 punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment
24 for a term of not more than six months, or by any combination of
25 such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation of this
26 ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

27 SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
28 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
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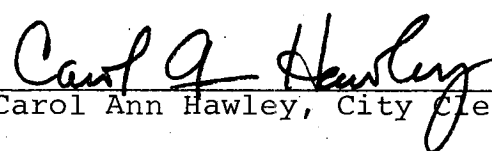
1 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
