AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 52, SECTION 170 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1983 EDITION, BY DELETING THE REFERENCES TO "BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS", "BOARD" AND "DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICES" AND INSERTING IN LIEU THEREOF REFERENCES TO "CITY COUNCIL", "COUNCIL" AND "DIRECTOR OF ENGINEERING SERVICES", RESPECTIVELY; ADDING AN ADDITIONAL BASIS FOR THE GRANTING OF A WAIVER TO THE REQUIREMENT OF INSTALLING EXISTING DISTRIBUTION LINES UNDERGROUND; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

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THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Las Vegas Municipal Code, Section 13.52.170
is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.52.170: (A) An application may be made to the Director of [Public] Engineering Services requesting approval by the [Board of Commissioners] City Council of a waiver of the requirements of this Chapter pertaining to underground installation of an existing distribution line for the following reasons:

- (1) Extensions of services requiring the replacement, relocation, re-erection or reconstruction of a distribution line less than one-half of a mile in length;
- (2) In cases of emergency where [the] public health and safety [will] would be [injured;] jeopardized;
- (3) Unavailability of materials necessary for

- 1 underground installation;
- 2 (4) Topographical or subsurface conditions making
- 3 such underground installations economically
- 4 unreasonable or impractical.
- 5 (5) Requiring the underground installation does
- 6 not promote the purposes stated under
- 7 Section 13.52.010, or is unreasonable due
- 8 to other circumstances presented by the
- 9 applicant.

10 (B) The application shall be reviewed by the Director

11 of [Public] Engineering Services who shall make

12 recommendations for approval or denial to the

13 [Board] Council. After reviewing the recommenda-

14 tions of the Director of [Public] Engineering

15 Services, the [Board] Council shall approve the

16 application if it comes within one of the cate-

17 gories set out in Subsection (A) of this Section

18 for which a waiver shall be granted to the

19 applicant.

20 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,

21 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part

22 thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid

23 or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such

24 decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the

25 remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The City

26 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it

27 would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,

28 sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that

29 any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,

30 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,

31 invalid or ineffective.

32 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,

1 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
2 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
3 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

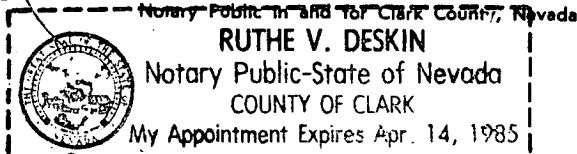
