

ORDINANCE NO. 198

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF BEER, WINE OR OTHER BEVERAGES WHICH ARE NOW OR MAY HEREAFTER BE AUTHORIZED BY THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES TO BE SOLD OR DISTRIBUTED; REGULATING PLACES WHERE AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH SUCH LIQUORS OR BEVERAGES MAY BE SOLD OR OTHERWISE DISTRIBUTED; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND LICENSES AND THE IMPOSING OF TAXES; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

Section 1. For the purposes of this Ordinance, a retail liquor or beverage establishment, a wholesale liquor or beverage establishment, and liquors and beverages are defined as follows: A retail liquor establishment is defined to be a place where liquors or beverages, as herein defined, are sold, served or given away, provided that such liquors or beverages may be sold, served or given away in quantities not to exceed 4 9/10ths gallons, to the same person or for the use of the same person, at any one time

A wholesale liquor establishment is defined to be a place where liquors or beverages, as herein defined, are sold, served or given away, or distributed ~~in~~, in quantities of not less than 5 gallons, contained in sealed or corked packages or kegs, and not to be consumed upon the premises where so sold, served, given away or distributed ~~in~~.

A beverage or liquor shall be defined as any vinous, malt or other liquor which now is, or may hereafter be, authorized by the laws of the United States to be sold or distributed.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, to sell, offer to sell, serve or give away, or cause or permit to be sold, served, or given away, any liquor or beverage, as herein defined, in the City of Las Vegas, without first making application for and securing a permit and license so to do; provided that any such liquor or beverage may be served by a private family at home as a part of its family life; or provided further, that the provisions of this Section shall not apply to the sale or giving away by regularly licensed druggists of any of such liquors or beverages upon a physician's certificate.

Any violation of any provision of this Section shall constitute a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail of Las Vegas for a period of not less than thirty days nor more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. Whenever any person desires to open, keep, carry on or conduct a wholesale or retail liquor or beverage establishment in the City of Las Vegas, or engage in the business thereof, such person shall make application in writing to the Board of Commissioners of said City for permission to obtain a liquor or beverage license, and said application shall contain and set forth the following:

- (a) The name and residence of the applicant or applicants, and how long a resident of the City of Las Vegas;
- (b) The kind of license desired (whether a wholesale license or a retail license), and the particular place for which such license is desired, and the name of the owner of the premises wherein such business is to be conducted;
- (c) The person or persons interested in the business asked to be licensed;
- (d) A statement that if such permit is granted and a license issued, same will be accepted by applicant subject to the terms and provisions of this Ordinance and to such other rules and regulations as may at any time hereafter be adopted or enacted

by resolution of the Board of Commissioners of said City of Las Vegas; (e) Said application must be verified by the applicant or applicants therefor.

Section 4. The Board of Commissioners of said City of Las Vegas may, if the applicant or applicants for permission to obtain a license is, or are, in the opinion of said Board, a proper person or persons to carry on such business, make an order that the City Clerk issue a license to such person or persons, upon the payment of the sum required for the particular kind of license for which the application is made.

Section 5. When an applicant for a permit or a license is a corporation or association, the application may be verified by its President, Secretary or Manager, and in addition to the matters and things hereinbefore required to be set out in the application, there shall be set forth the name of the person or persons who shall have the management of its business for which or in connection with which a license is desired, and the names of the persons composing its Board of Directors or governing body.

Section 6. Any license to conduct any of the businesses herein mentioned, granted and issued by the Board of City Commissioners shall continue in force for a period of one year from the date of issuance unless such license shall have been revoked, cancelled or declared forfeit; but the Board of City Commissioners may at any time in its discretion, without notice, revoke, rescind or cancel any permit for a license theretofore granted, and may cancel and declare forfeit any license issued; and every licensee accepts the permit granted and the license issued subject to such right of revocation without notice; provided, however that if any such license is declared forfeited or cancelled without the preferment of charges against or the giving of notice to the holder thereof, there shall, on the cancellation or forfeiture of such license, be returned to such former licensee, upon his application therefor, the pro rata portion of the license fee for the balance of the year for which payment was theretofore made in advance.

If neither the permit received nor the license granted under the provisions of this ordinance be rescinded, revoked or cancelled, the licensee may renew his license, upon application therefor, annually thereafter, by paying at the time of making application for such renewal the amount of the license tax as herein specified, or which may hereafter be fixed by the Board of City Commissioners. All license payments to be paid in advance for each year and to be paid in lawful money of the United States at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas.

Section 7. Permits for licenses shall be renewed annually upon the filing of the verified application required by Sections 3 and 5 of this ordinance.

Section 8. All licenses provided for in this ordinance shall, when issued, be issued for a period of one year, and no license shall be issued unless the applicant shall have first procured a permit for a license as hereinbefore provided and shall have paid the required license fee.

Section 9. No license, either wholesale or retail, shall be issued to any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, unless the applicant or applicants shall have an established place of business in the City of Las Vegas, is or are citizens of the United States, and registered voters of the State of Nevada.

Section 10. The rates for the licenses provided for in this ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby fixed and established and the same shall be paid by all persons receiving such licenses

respectively, as follows: For a retail liquor or beverage license the sum of \$ 40<sup>00</sup>, per year, provided that retail drug stores or grocery stores shall not be required to pay more than \$ 90<sup>00</sup> per year for such retail liquor or beverage license; ~~when the priv-~~

and provided further that drug stores and grocery stores shall not be permitted to sell, serve, distribute or give away any liquor or beverage except in unbroken packages not to be consumed on the premises.

~~issued shall also indicate that the same is granted to a retail drug or grocery store under the provisions of this section. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning, in charge of, or employed, in the retail drug or grocery store handling liquor or beverages under such license at such reduced price, to sell, serve or give away or cause or permit to be sold, served or given away therein any liquor or beverage to be drunk or consumed upon the premises; and it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning, or in charge of, or employed in such retail drug or grocery store handling liquors or beverages under such license at such reduced price, to cause, permit or allow any liquor or beverages to be drunk or consumed on the premises thereof.~~

For a wholesale liquor or beverage license, the sum of \$ 50<sup>00</sup> per year.

Section 11. In addition to the license tax in this ordinance provided, there shall be paid to the City of Las Vegas an excise tax of 4¢ cents per gallon for each gallon or fraction thereof of any liquor or beverage authorized or permitted by this ordinance sold, served, distributed or given away. The payment of said additional tax shall be made monthly by the wholesaler selling, distributing or giving away the liquors or beverages in this ordinance permitted to be sold, distributed or given away, and shall be paid to the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas or other person designated by the Board of City Commissioners of said City to collect the same, on or before the 5th day of each month, on all sales made during the preceding month.

Any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, engaging in the wholesale distribution of liquors or beverages, as herein defined, and permitted, shall keep full, true and correct books of account setting forth in detail the date of sale, amount of each sale, to whom such sale was made, and where delivered, and shall at all times allow the Board of City Commissioners or such person as said Board may designate, a free and full inspection of said books; and said wholesaler as herein defined shall furnish for inspection any and all expense bills showing in detail the amount or amounts of liquors or beverages received or purchased for resale, together with the date of receipt thereof, from whom purchased, and how and by whom delivered.

In the event retail liquor or beverage dealers engaged in the business of selling, serving, distributing or giving away liquors or beverages, as in this ordinance defined, shall purchase for resale liquors or beverages from wholesalers or others not having a license in said City of Las Vegas, or shall purchase any liquor or beverage upon which said excise tax of 4¢ cents per gallon, as in this ordinance provided, has not been paid, shall, ~~before selling, serving, giving away, or otherwise disposing of said beverage,~~ pay such tax in addition to the license fee. ~~and~~

~~any~~ retail liquor or beverage dealer purchasing liquors or beverages other than from a regularly licensed wholesale dealer

in said City of Las Vegas, shall, in addition to the other requirements in this ordinance contained, keep full true and correct books of account, in the same manner as required by wholesalers, as set out in the last preceding paragraph hereof, and shall pay to the City said additional tax monthly, at the time and in the manner as hereinbefore mentioned; and said books so kept shall be open to inspection by the Board of City Commissioners or by any person by them authorized and designated.

Section 12. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning, conducting, or having charge of the business of a retail liquor or beverage establishment, or any employee of the same, to sell, serve or give away, or cause or permit to be sold, served or given away in any such establishment, or otherwise, or at all, at any one time or to or for the use of the same person, any of the liquors or beverages, as herein defined, in excess of 4 9/10ths gallons.

Section 13. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning, conducting, or having charge of the business of a wholesale liquor or beverage establishment, or any employee of the same, to sell, serve or give away or cause or permit to be sold, served or given away, any liquor or beverage as herein defined, or to distribute the same, except in quantities of not less than five (5) gallons, and in sealed or unbroken packages or in kegs.

Section 14. No person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, shall be granted both a retail and a wholesale license at one and the same time; and no person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, having a wholesale liquor or beverage license, shall sell any of the liquor or beverages herein mentioned to anyone not having a retail liquor or beverage license.

Section 15. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, to sell, serve, distribute, or give away any of the liquors or beverages in this ordinance mentioned, within Four Hundred feet of any school house or place where school is conducted.

Section 16. Any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, subject to the payment of the excise tax in this ordinance mentioned, shall, in addition to the requirements in this ordinance contained, execute a bond to the City of Las Vegas in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), conditioned that the person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, giving said bond will pay to said City of Las Vegas any and all tax due. Said bond shall be in form as required by the Board of City Commissioners, and subject to its approval.

Section 17. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply only to the granting of licenses and the permission to sell, serve, distribute, or give away, any of the liquors or beverages that now are or may hereafter be authorized by the laws of the United States.


Section 18. Any violation of this ordinance or any one of the provisions thereof, or any of the prohibitions thereof, or any of the requirements thereof, shall constitute a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars

Section 23. This Ordinance to take effect immediately after its passage and publication, and this Ordinance is passed as an emergency Ordinance.

Section 24. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to have this Ordinance published in Las Vegas Bee, a daily newspaper published in said City of Las Vegas, for a period of two weeks, that is to say: once each week.

The Board of Commissioners of  
the city of Las Vegas do ordain as

Section 1. For the purposes of this  
Ordinance, a retail liquor or beve-  
rage establishment, a wholesale  
liquor or beverage establishment,  
and liquors and beverages are de-  
fined as follows: A retail liquor  
establishment is defined to be a  
place where liquors or beverages, as  
herein defined, are sold, served or  
given away, provided that such  
liquors or beverages may be sold  
served or given away in quantities  
not to exceed 4 9-10 gallons to  
the same person or for the use of  
the same person, at any one time.

A wholesale liquor establishment  
is defined to be a place where li-  
quors or beverages, as herein defined,  
are sold, served or given away, or  
distributed in quantities of  
not less than 5 gallons, contained  
in sealed or corked packages or  
kegs, and not to be consumed upon  
the premises where so sold, served,  
given away or distributed.

A beverage or liquor shall be  
defined as any vinous, malt or other  
liquor which now is, or may here-  
after be, authorized by the laws of  
the United States to be sold or  
distributed.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for  
any person, firm, corporation, co-  
partnership, association, social  
club, or association of persons of  
any kind whatsoever, to sell, offer  
to sell, serve or give away, or cause  
or permit to be sold, served, or  
given away, any liquor or beverage,  
as herein defined, in the City of Las  
Vegas, without first making ap-  
plication for and securing a permit  
and license so to do; provided that  
any such liquor or beverage may  
be served by a private family at  
home as a part of its family life; or  
provided further, that the provi-  
sions of this Section shall  
not apply to the sale or giving  
away by regularly licensed drug  
gists of any of such liquors or bev-  
erages upon physician's certificate.

Any violation of any provision  
of this section shall constitute a  
misdemeanor, and shall be punish-  
able by a fine of not less than  
Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than  
Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00),  
or by imprisonment in the City Jail  
of Las Vegas for a period of not  
less than thirty days nor more than  
six months; or by both such fine  
and imprisonment.

Section 3. Whenever any person  
desires to open, keep, carry on or  
conduct a wholesale or retail liquor  
or beverage establishment in the

ance shall be, and the same are hereby fixed and established and the same shall be paid by all persons receiving such licenses respectively, as follows: For a retail liquor or beverage license the sum of \$40.00 per year, provided that retail drug stores or grocery stores shall not be required to pay more than \$30.00 per year for such retail liquor or beverage license; and provided further that drug stores and grocery stores shall not be permitted to sell, serve, distribute or give away any liquor or beverage except in unbroken packages not to be consumed on the premises. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning, in charge of, or employed, in a retail drug or grocery store handling liquor or beverages under such license at such reduced price, to sell, serve or give away or cause or permit to be sold, served or given away therein any liquor or beverage to be drunk or consumed upon the premises; and it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning or in charge of, or employed in such retail drug or grocery store handling liquors or beverages under such license at such reduced price, to cause, permit or allow any liquor or beverages to be drunk or consumed on the premises thereof.

For a wholesale liquor or beverage license, the sum of \$50.00 per year.

Section 11. In addition to the license tax in this ordinance provided, there shall be paid to the City of Las Vegas an excise tax of four cents per gallon for each gallon or fraction thereof of any liquor or beverage authorized or permitted by this ordinance, sold, served, distributed or given away. The payment of said additional tax shall be made monthly by the wholesaler selling, distributing or giving away the liquors or beverages in this ordinance permitted to be sold, distributed or given away, and shall be paid to the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas or other person designated by the Board of City Commissioners of said City to collect the same, on or before the 5th day of each month, on all sales made during the preceding month.

Any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club or association of persons of

any kind whatsoever, engaging in the wholesale distribution of liquors or beverages, as herein defined and permitted, shall keep full, true and correct books of account setting forth in detail the date of sale, amount of each sale, to whom such sale was made, and where delivered, and shall at all times allow the Board of City Commissioners or such person as said Board may designate a free and full inspection of said books; and said wholesaler as herein defined shall furnish for inspection any and all expense bills showing in detail the amount or amounts of liquors or beverages received or purchased for resale, together with the date of receipt thereof, from whom purchased, and how and by whom delivered.

In the event retail liquor or beverage dealer's engaged in the business of selling, serving, distributing or giving away liquors or beverages as in this ordinance defined, shall purchase for resale liquors or beverages from wholesalers or others not having a license in said City of Las Vegas, or shall purchase any liquor or beverage upon which said excise tax of four cents per gallon, as in this ordinance provided, has not been paid, then such dealers shall pay such tax in addition to the license fee. Any retail liquor or beverage dealer purchasing liquors or beverages other than from a regularly licensed wholesale dealer in said City of Las Vegas, shall, in addition to the other requirements in this ordinance contained, keep full, true and correct books of account in the same manner as required by wholesalers, as set out in the last preceding paragraph hereof, and shall pay to the City said additional tax monthly, at the time and in the manner as hereinbefore mentioned, and said books, so kept shall be open to inspection by the Board of City Commissioners or by any person by them authorized and designated.

Section 12. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning, conducting, or having charge of the business of a retail liquor or beverage establishment, or any employee of the same, to sell, serve or give away, or cause or permit to be sold, served, or given away in any such establishment, or otherwise, or at all, at any one time or to or for the use of the same person, any of

the liquors or beverages, as herein defined, in excess of 4 9-10 gallons.

Section 13. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, owning, conducting, or having charge of the business of a wholesale liquor or beverage establishment, or any employee of the same, to sell, serve or give away, or cause or permit to be sold, served, or given away any liquor or beverage as herein defined, or to distribute the same, except in quantities of not less than five (5) gallons, and in sealed or unbroken packages or in kegs.

Section 14. No person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, shall be granted both a retail and a wholesale license at one and the same time, and no person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, having a wholesale liquor or beverage license, shall sell any of the liquor or beverages herein mentioned to anyone not having a retail liquor or beverage license.

Section 15. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, to sell, serve, distribute, or give away any of the liquors or beverages in this ordinance mentioned, within Four Hundred feet of any school house or place where school is conducted.

Section 16. Any person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, subject to the payment of the excise tax in this ordinance mentioned, shall in addition to the requirements in this ordinance contained, execute a bond to the City of Las Vegas in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), conditioned that the person, firm, corporation, co-partnership, association, social club, or association of persons of any kind whatsoever, giving said bond will pay to said City of Las Vegas any and all tax due. Said bond shall be in form as required by the Board of City Commissioners, and subject to its approval.

Section 17. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply only to the granting of licenses and the permission to sell, serve, distribute, or give away, any of the liquors or beverages that now are or may hereafter be authorized by the laws of the United States.

Section 18. Any violation of this ordinance or any one of the provisions thereof, or any of the prohibitions thereof, or any of the requirements thereof, shall constitute a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) or by imprisonment in the City Jail of Las Vegas for a period of not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, and shall subject the licensee to having his license revoked, cancelled or annulled; and any person being adjudged guilty of the violation of this ordinance or any of the provisions thereof, or any of the prohibitions thereof, may, in the discretion of the Board of City Commissioners, be denied a permit or license thereafter. Any owner or proprietor of any kind of business licensed under this ordinance, who shall violate or permit a violation of this ordinance, or any of the provisions thereof, in his or her or its place of business, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment in the City Jail of Las Vegas for a period of not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 19. The Board of City Commissioners are invested with power to punish violations of this Ordinance and with power to revoke permits and cancel licenses, and to suspend the same should it deem such action justifiable.

Section 20. No permit granted or license issued under this Ordinance shall be assignable, except to a bona fide purchaser of the business to which it was granted or issued, and then only after the consent in writing of the Board of Commissioners of said City of Las Vegas first had and obtained, upon application therefor filed, containing, in addition to the requirements specified for obtaining an original permit and license, a statement setting forth such transfer and proposed transfer of the business. Such application must be verified by both assignor and assignee.

Section 21. It shall be lawful for the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas to refuse to grant permits or licenses for the conduct of any business mentioned in this ordinance, in the residential district of the City of Las Vegas, and said Board shall have the power to limit the number of retail and wholesale licenses to be issued, and to designate where in said City any of said liquors or beverages may be sold, served, distributed or given away, and to refuse to issue a license to any applicant who violates any of the laws of the State of Nevada or of the United States.

Section 22. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 23. This Ordinance to take effect immediately after its passage and publication, and this Ordinance is passed as an emergency Ordinance.

Section 24. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to have this Ordinance published in the Las Vegas Age, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Las Vegas, for a period of two weeks, that is to say: once each week.
