ORDINANCE NO. 3850

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO BUSINESS LICENSE FEES; AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTERS 4, 50, 52, 62, 81, AND 83, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO REFLECT PERMISSIBLE INCREASES IN BUSINESS LICENSE FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HERewith.

Summary: Increases the semiannual business license fee for certain specified businesses not falling within that category of business charged a fee based on the gross sales of the business.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 105, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.04.105: The license fee is [twenty-five dollars] thirty-five dollars semiannually for the first barber in a shop and ten dollars semiannually for each additional barber in the same shop. A State license must first be obtained to operate a barbershop.

SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 140, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.04.140: Any person operating a public bus transportation service for the carrying of passengers from place to place in the City shall pay a semiannual license fee of [twenty-five dollars] fifty dollars for each bus used in such transportation service. The applicant must file an application designating the routes with the City Clerk and meet Public Service Commission requirements before such license may be approved by the Board of Commissioners.

SECTION 3: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 175, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.04.175: For each cosmetological establishment issued a State license under NRS 644, the fee

1 is [twenty-five dollars] thirty-five dollars semiannually for the first person practicing cosmetology
2 as defined by NRS 644.020(3), which includes hairdressers, manicurists and electrologists, and
3 ten dollars for each additional person practicing cosmetology therein.

4 SECTION 4: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 240, of the Municipal Code of the
5 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6 **6.04.240:** The license fee for an express or delivery service is twenty-five dollars semiannually
7 for the first vehicle and [twelve dollars and fifty cents] fifteen dollars semiannually for each
8 additional vehicle used in the business. An applicant for this license must furnish a Public Service
9 Commission certificate or written verification that such certificate is not required. For vehicles
10 used in connection with transfer and storage businesses, see Section 6.04.575.

11 SECTION 5: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 560, of the Municipal Code of the
12 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 **6.04.560:** (A) The license fee for a time-share representative as defined by NRS 119A.120 is
14 [one hundred dollars] five hundred dollars semiannually.

15 (B) The license fee for a time-share sales agent as defined by NRS
16 119A.130 is [one hundred dollars] five hundred dollars semiannually.

17 (C) The license fee for a time-share project broker as defined by NRS
18 119A.090 is one-half of one percent of the total sales volume of time-shares on a quarterly basis.

19 SECTION 6: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 575, of the Municipal Code of the
20 City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 **6.04.575:** The license fee for a transfer and storage company is twenty-five dollars semiannually
22 for the first truck in the business and [twelve dollars and fifty cents] fifteen dollars for each
23 additional truck used in the business. The applicant must furnish certificates of public
24 convenience and necessity from the Public Service Commission in accordance with NRS 706.

25 SECTION 7: Title 6, Chapter 50, Section 230, of the Municipal Code of
26 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 **6.50.230:** Each licensee shall pay to the Department of Business Activity the license fees set forth
2 in the following schedule:

11 Each special event general licensee shall pay a license fee of fifty dollars per day.

12 Each special event beer/wine/cooler licensee shall pay a license fee of twenty-five
13 dollars per day.

14 SECTION 8: Title 6, Chapter 52, Section 280, of the Municipal Code of
15 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 **6.52.280:** Each masseur and masseuse must pay in advance a semiannual permit fee of [twenty-
17 five] fifty dollars. Failure to pay such fee within fifteen days of its due date shall subject the
18 masseur or masseuse to the penalties described in Section 6.02.250.

19 SECTION 9: Title 6, Chapter 62, Section 230, of the Municipal Code of
20 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 **6.62.230:** Each temporary merchant shall pay in advance a license fee of [ten dollars per day for
22 each day of operation] one hundred fifty dollars for operations of thirty-one days duration or less.

23 SECTION 10: Title 6, Chapter 81, Section 40, of the Municipal Code of
24 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983, Edition is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 **6.81.040:** Every licensee shall pay to the Director in advance, on a semi-annual basis, a fee of
26

1 [twenty-five dollars] two hundred dollars for each day the theme park of permanent exhibition is
2 in operation.

3 SECTION 11: Title 6, Chapter 83, Section 100, of the Municipal Code of
4 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 **6.83.100:** Each person who is required to be licensed by this Chapter shall pay a semiannual
6 premises license fee in the amount of [fifty] one hundred dollars and the coin-operated amusement
7 machine license fee that is set forth in LVMC 6.26.030 for each film or videotape viewing device
8 that is located on the premises.

9 SECTION 12: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence,
10 clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be
11 unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision
12 shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part
13 thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed
14 each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective
15 of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses
16 or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

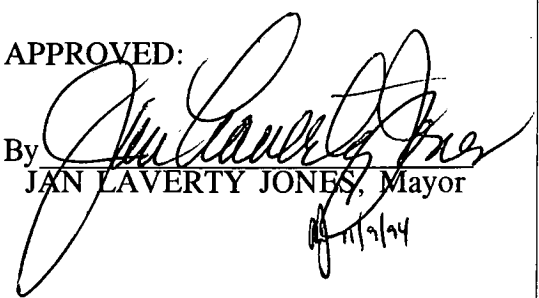
17 SECTION 13: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections,
18 phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las
19 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
