ORDINANCE NO. 3828

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LIQUOR CONTROL; AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 50, SECTION 170, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY PROHIBITING PERSONS FROM ENGAGING IN AND ADVERTISING THE BUSINESS OF SELLING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING AND THEREAFTER MAINTAINING A VALID UNEXPIRED LICENSE PURSUANT TO SAID CODE; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Prohibits persons from engaging in and advertising a business that sells alcoholic beverages without first obtaining and maintaining a valid unexpired business license.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 50, Section 170, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.50.170: No person shall engage in the business of selling alcoholic beverages, or advertising the same, without first obtaining and thereafter maintaining a valid unexpired license pursuant to this Code.

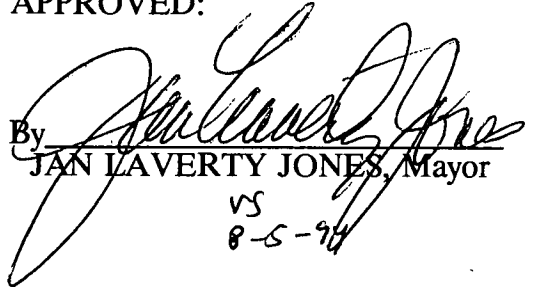
SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las

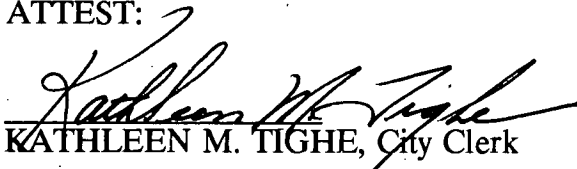
