3 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COLLECTION OF SEWER SERVICE CHARGES
4 AND SURCHARGES; AMENDING TITLE 14, CHAPTER 4, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
5 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO TWO
6 NEW SUBSECTIONS, DESIGNATED AS SUBSECTIONS 105 AND 185, RESPECTIVELY,
7 TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO PLACE DELINQUENT SEWER SERVICE CHARGES AND
DELINQUENT SEWER SERVICE SURCHARGES ON THE COUNTY'S GENERAL TAX
ROLLS TO BE COLLECTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS GENERAL TAXES; PROVIDING
FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL
ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

11 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY
12 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

13 SECTION 1: Title 14, Chapter 4, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
14 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as
15 Section 105, reading as follows:

16 14.04.105: As an alternative to any other method of collection of sewer charges provided by
17 this Chapter, the City may place delinquent sewer charges on the County's general tax roll to be
18 collected along with general taxes in accordance with NRS Chapter 268. The City may include
19 in such charges any charges associated with the use of the tax roll system, the collection of
20 delinquent charges, and the recordation and release of liens.

21 SECTION 2: Title 14, Chapter 4, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
22 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as
23 Section 185, reading as follows:

24 14.04.185: As an alternative to any other method of collection of sewer service surcharges
25 provided by this Chapter, the City may place delinquent sewer service surcharges on the County's
26 general tax roll to be collected along with general taxes in accordance with NRS Chapter 268.

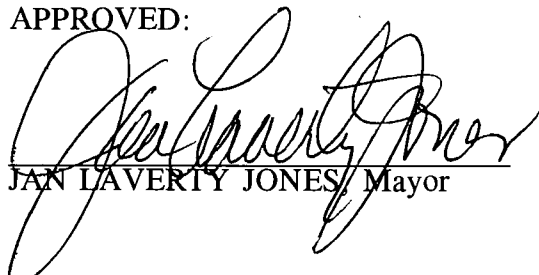
1 The City may include in such charges any charges associated with the use of the tax roll system,
2 the collection of delinquent charges, and the recordation and release of liens.

3 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence,
4 clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional
5 or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
6 validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City
7 Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section,
8 subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that
9 any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases
10 be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

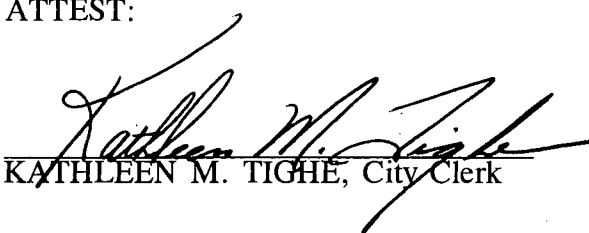
11 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections,
12 phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las
13 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

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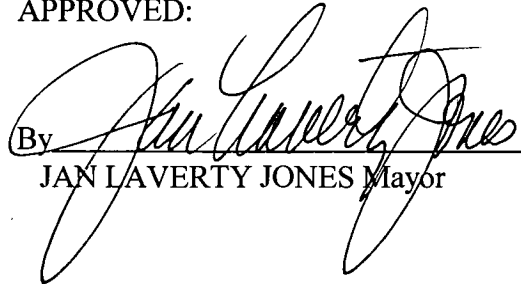

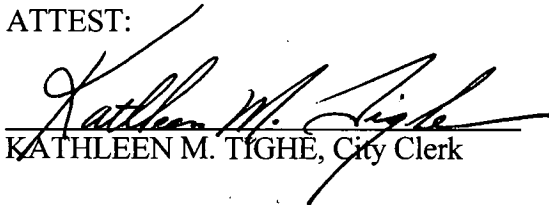
