

ORDINANCE NO. 1126

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1092 RELATIVE TO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL BY PROVIDING FOR THE REDUCTION OF REPRESENTATION OF CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA, ON THE CLARK COUNTY JOINT BOARD FOR CONTROL OF AIR POLLUTION FROM THREE (3) MEMBERS TO ONE (1) MEMBER; FOR FUNCTIONAL OPERATION OF SAID JOINT BOARD FOR CONTROL OF AIR POLLUTION FOR AN INITIAL PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS, AT WHICH TIME CONSIDERATION SHALL BE GIVEN AND ACTION TAKEN FOR INCLUSION OF THE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL FUNCTIONS WITHIN AND UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE CLARK COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE COMPOSITION AND REPRESENTATION OF THE HEARING BOARD, SO THAT THE SAME SHALL CONSIST OF ONE (1) MEMBER FROM THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, ONE (1) MEMBER FROM THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AND ONE (1) MEMBER FROM THE GOVERNING BOARD OR COUNCIL OF ANY OTHER PARTICIPATING CITY.

THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 3, paragraph 1(a) of Ordinance No. 1092 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. AIR POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD: COMPOSITION; MEETINGS; POWERS AND DUTIES.

1. The Clark County Joint Board for Control of Air Pollution, heretofore created by cooperative agreement pursuant to the provisions of NRS 277.070 between and among Clark County and the incorporated cities in Clark County, shall consist of:

- (a) One member of the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County shall be designated by the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 2. Section 3 of said ordinance is further amended by adding thereto a new paragraph designated as paragraph 6, providing as follows:

6. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit or restrict the consolidation of the functional operations of the Joint Board for control of air pollution as a part of and under the Clark County Health District Department after a period of two years, upon approval and appropriate action taken therefor by the parties to the cooperative agreement, as amended, made by the parties pursuant to the provision of NRS 277.070.

SECTION 3. Section 4, paragraph 1, of said ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 4. HEARING BOARD: COMPOSITION; POWERS AND DUTIES; APPEALS TO CONTROL BOARD; DE NOVO HEARINGS.

1. A hearing board, composed of three members of the control board, in the manner hereinafter specified, is hereby created. The said hearing board shall consist of one member from the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada, one member from the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, and one member from the governing board or council of any other participating city, selected by the control board.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
