

ORDINANCE NO. 1196

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE I, CHAPTER 7 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, PROVIDING FOR A LONGEVITY PAY PLAN FOR CIVIL SERVICE AND APPOINTIVE PERSONNEL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; PROVIDING FOR THE AMOUNT THEREOF AND THE PERIOD OF TENURE; PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATORY HAZARD PAY; PROVIDING FOR TWO NEW SECTIONS, ENTITLED SECTION 7 AND SECTION 8; AMENDING SECTION 3 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title I, Chapter 7, Section 3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-7-3: The rates of pay enumerated in Section 1 hereof, except as provided in Title I, Chapter 7, Sections 7 and 8, shall constitute the total salary or wages received by employees for regular full-time employment. Appropriate compensation may be made for authorized overtime.

SECTION 2. Title I, Chapter 7 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated Section 7, to read as follows:

1-7-7: There is hereby instituted a longevity pay plan which shall apply to full-time civil service and appointive personnel of the City, which plan shall be over and above the rates of pay enumerated in Title I, Chapter 7, Section 1, and is hereby defined as follows: Upon completion of six (6) consecutive years of employment, an employee shall receive an additional three per cent (3%) of his base bi-weekly salary; an employee, after acquiring six (6) years of tenure, shall receive an additional one-half per cent increase each year thereafter until a maximum of ten per cent (10%) has been reached for twenty (20) years' service or longer of continuous employment with the City of Las Vegas. Overtime shall not be considered in the calculation of longevity pay. Said longevity pay plan shall become effective upon the anniversary date of an employee.

SECTION 3. Title I, Chapter 7 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated Section 8, to read as follows:

1-7-8: Commencing on and after July 1, 1965, commissioned personnel assigned to the Traffic Division who ride a motorcycle in the course of their duties shall receive compensatory hazard pay in the sum of Forty (\$40.00) Dollars per month; commissioned personnel assigned to the K-9 Corps on a regular basis shall receive compensatory hazard pay in the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars per month; patrolmen or policewomen assigned to the Detective Division on a regular basis shall receive compensatory hazard pay in the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars per month, in addition to the pay schedule in Title I, Chapter 7, Section 1.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 1191
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 7 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, PROVIDING FOR A LONGEVITY PAY PLAN FOR CIVIL SERVICE AND APPOINTIVE PERSONNEL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, PROVIDING FOR THE AMOUNT THEREOF AND THE PERIOD OF TENURE, PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATORY HAZARD PAY, PROVIDING FOR TWO NEW SECTIONS, ENTITLED SECTION 7 AND SECTION 8, AMENDING SECTIONS OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER, PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERE-TO, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title 1, Chapter 7 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
1-7-1. The rates of pay enumerated in Section 1 hereof, except as provided in Title 1, Chapter 7, Sections 7 and 8, shall constitute the total salary or wages received by employees for regular, full-time employment. Appropriate compensation may be made for authorized overtime.

SECTION 2. Title 1, Chapter 7 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section designated Section 7, to read as follows:
1-7-2. There is hereby instituted a longevity pay plan which shall apply to full-time civil service and appointive personnel of the City, which plan shall be over and above the rates of pay enumerated in Title 1, Chapter 7, Section 1, and is hereby defined as follows: Upon completion of six (6) consecutive years of employment an employee shall receive an additional three per cent (3%) of his base biweekly salary; an employee, after acquiring six (6) years of tenure, shall receive an additional one-half per cent increase each year thereafter until a maximum of ten per cent (10%) has been reached for twenty (20) years' service or longer of continuous employment with the City of Las Vegas. Overtime shall not be considered in the calculation of longevity pay. Said longevity pay plan shall become effective upon the anniversary date of an employee.

SECTION 3. Title 1, Chapter 7 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section designated Section 8, to read as follows:
1-7-8. Commencing on and after July 1, 1965, commissioned personnel assigned to the Traffic Division who ride a motorcycle in the course of their duties shall receive compensatory hazard pay in the sum of Forty (\$40.00) Dollars per month; commissioned personnel assigned to the K-9 Corps on a regular basis shall receive compensatory hazard pay in the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars per month; patrolmen or policewomen assigned to the Detective Division on a regular basis shall receive compensatory hazard pay in the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars per month, in addition to the pay schedule in Title 1, Chapter 7, Section 1.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. PASSED, ADOPTED AND APPROVED, this 7th day of July, 1965.
