

ORDINANCE NO. 1203

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 4 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960, REGULATING THE SALE, GIFT OR RAFFLING OF ANIMALS, REPTILES, FISH AND FOWL; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 2, Section 4 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection, designated Subsection (V), to read as follows:

(V): GIVING AWAY OF ANIMALS, FISH OR REPTILES: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation in connection with any advertising campaign or promotion to give, or offer to give, as a gift or prize any live animal, reptile, bird or fish of any description whatsoever or for any owner, operator or agent of any carnival, fair or amusement park to use any live animal, reptile, bird or fish as or for a target or to use any live animal, reptile, bird or fish in any cruel or unusual manner; provided, however, this shall not prohibit the proper display of animals, birds, fish or reptiles in proper facilities for educational purposes.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
