

ORDINANCE NO. 1221

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IV, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 2, SUBSECTION B OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO PARAGRAPH 30, "V-TYPE SIGN," AND PARAGRAPH 31, "WALL SIGN"; BY AMENDING TITLE IV, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 12, SUBSECTION (G), BY PROVIDING THAT ADVERTISING SIGNS OR BILLBOARDS SHALL NOT BE PLACED IN R-ZONE; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IV, Chapter 6, Section 2, Subsection B of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto paragraphs 30 and 31, to read as follows:

4-6-2: (30) "V-Type sign" means a double angle sign facing two (2) directions connected or joined structurally.

(31) "Wall sign" means a removable sign structure which is affixed to an exterior wall of any building and/or structure, when such sign shall project not more than eight inches (8") from the building wall.

SECTION 2. Title IV, Chapter 6, Section 12, Subsection (G) of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

4-6-12: (G) Signs or billboards whose advertising matter pertains to something, or some place remote from the origin of such sign shall not be placed in any R-Zone.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 and/or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

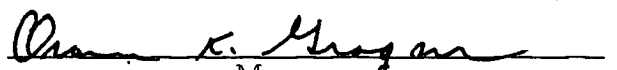

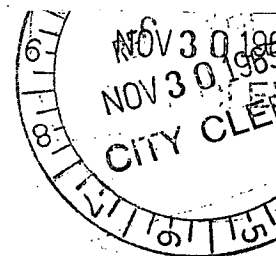

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IV, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 2, SUBSECTION (G) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERE TO PARAGRAPH 30, "V" TYPE SIGN, AND PARAGRAPH 31, "W" TYPE SIGN, BY AMENDING TITLE V, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 12, SUBSECTION (G), BY PROVIDING THAT ADVERTISING SIGNS OR BILLBOARDS SHALL NOT BE PLACED IN R-ZONE, PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERE TO, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION HEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith. THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1. Title IV, Chapter 6, Section 12, Subsection (G) of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto paragraphs 30 and 31, to read as follows:
4-12-1 (G)
"V" type sign means a double angle sign facing two (2) directions connected or joined structurally.
4-12-2 (G)
"W" type sign means a removable sign structure which is affixed to an exterior wall of any building and or structure. When such sign shall project not more than eight inches (8") from the building wall.
SECTION 2. Title IV, Chapter 6, Section 12, Subsection (G) of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
4-12-1 (G)
Signs or billboards whose advertising matter pertains to something, or some place, remote from the origin of such sign shall not be placed in any R-Zone.
SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 and or imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.
SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
