

ORDINANCE NO. 1224

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IV, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 5 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, PROVIDING FOR THE AMOUNT OF PERMIT FEE FOR INSTALLATION OF SEWER LINE; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IV, Chapter 2, Section 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended, effective January 1, 1966, to read as follows:

4-2-5: COST OF PERMIT: Every applicant for a permit to install, add to, alter, relocate, or replace a Plumbing or Drainage System, or part thereof, shall state in writing on the application form provided for that purpose the character of work proposed to be done and the amount and kind in connection therewith, together with such information pertinent thereto as may be required.

Any person who shall commence any plumbing work for which a permit is required by this Code without first having obtained a permit therefor shall, if subsequently permitted to obtain a permit, pay double the permit fee fixed by this section for such work; provided, however, that this provision shall not apply to emergency work when it shall be proved to the satisfaction of the Administrative Authority that such work was urgently necessary and that it was not practical to obtain a permit therefor before the commencement of the work. In all such cases a permit must be obtained as soon as it is practical to do so, and, if there be an unreasonable delay in obtaining such permit, a double fee as herein provided shall be charged. In the event the work is stopped in accordance with Section 3, the fees shall be double the normal charge if the person was at fault on such installation.

No plumbing permit will be issued for any building with respect to which a septic disposal system is to be installed until the applicant therefor has presented to the Department of Building and Safety a copy of a septic tank application approved by the Health Department. For the purpose of this section, a sanitary outlet on or to which a plumbing fixture or appliance may be set or attached shall be construed to be a fixture. Fees for reconnection and retest of existing plumbing systems in

relocated buildings shall be based on the number of plumbing fixtures, gas systems, water heaters, etc., involved.

When interceptor traps or house trailer site traps are installed at the same time as a house sewer on any lot, no sewer permit shall be required for the connection of any such trap to an appropriate inlet fitting provided in the house sewer by the permittee constructing such sewer.

When a permit has been obtained to connect an existing building or existing work to the public sewer or to connect to a new private disposal facility, backfilling of private sewage disposal facilities abandoned consequent to such connection is included in the house sewer permit.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

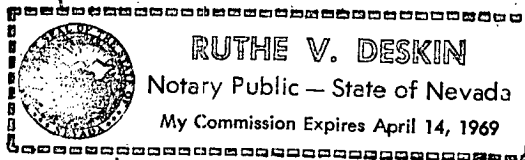

THE BOARD OF COMMISSION-
 ERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VE-
 GAS, NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN AS
 FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IV, Chapter 2,
 Section 5 of the Municipal Code of
 the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960
 Edition, is hereby amended, effective
 January 1, 1966, to read as fol-
 lows:

4-2-5: COST OF PERMIT: Every
 applicant for a permit to install, add
 to, alter, relocate, or replace a
 Plumbing or Drainage System, or
 part thereof, shall state in writing
 on the application form provided
 for that purpose the character of
 work proposed to be done and the
 amount and kind in connection
 therewith, together with such infor-
 mation pertinent thereto as may be
 required.

Any person who shall commence
 any plumbing work for which a
 permit is required by this Code
 without first having obtained a per-
 mit therefor shall, if subsequently
 permitted to obtain a permit, pay
 double the permit fee fixed by this
 section for such work; provided,
 however, that this provision shall
 not apply to emergency work when
 it shall be proved to the satisfaction
 of the Administrative Authority that
 such work was urgently necessary
 and that it was not practical to
 obtain a permit therefor before the
 commencement of the work. In all
 such cases a permit must be ob-
 tained as soon as it is practical to
 do so, and, if there be an unreason-
 able delay in obtaining such permit,
 a double fee as herein provided
 shall be charged. In the event the
 work is stopped in accordance with
 Section 3, the fees shall be double
 the normal charge if the person
 was at fault on such installation.

 sewage disposal facilities abandoned
 consequent to such connection is in-
 cluded in the house sewer permit.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or
 parts of ordinances, sections, sub-
 sections, phrases, sentences, clauses
 or paragraph contained in the Mu-
 nicipal Code of the City of Las
 Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in con-
 flict herewith are hereby repealed.
