

ORDINANCE NO. 1229

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 8, SECTION 3 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION BY PROVIDING FOR INTERMENTS NOT TO BE MADE ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS; PROVIDING FOR INTERMENTS ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IX, Chapter 8, Section 3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-8-3: INTERMENTS NOT TO BE MADE ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS: No interment shall be made on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day, except for reasons of health emergency upon the written order of the Health Department of the City. Interments on any Saturday or Sunday shall be made upon payment of an additional One Hundred (\$100) Dollars for each interment to defray cost of necessary personnel.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

 SECTION 1. Title IX, Chapter 8, Section 3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
 9-8-3: INTERMENTS NOT TO BE MADE ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS: No interment shall be made on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day, except for reasons of health emergency upon the written order of the Health Department. Interments on Saturday or Sunday shall be made upon payment of an additional fee of one hundred (\$100) dollars for each interment to defray cost of necessary personnel.  
 SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

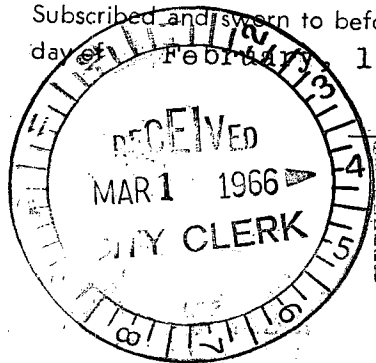
