ORDINANCE No. 3450

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LITTER; AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 12, SECTION 180, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO CLARIFY THE APPLICATION OF THE PENALTY PROVISIONS RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Clarifies that the penalty provisions of the litter ordinance apply to the storage of materials on private property where such storage is not permitted by the ordinance.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 9, Chapter 12, Section 180, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.12.180: Any person [violating] who violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of Sections 9.12.030, 9.12.050, 9.12.060 or 9.12.070 of this Chapter [shall upon conviction] is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than five hundred dollars, imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than thirty days or more than six months, or both. Every day of such violation constitutes a separate offense.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-

1 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared  
2 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

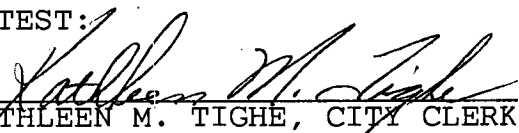
3 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
