THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 2, Section 360, of the  
Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
hereby amended to read as follows:

6.02.360: Upon a showing of good cause and in the discretion of  
the City Council, disciplinary action against a holder  
may take the form of cancellation, revocation, refusal  
to renew, suspension, imposition of conditions or  
restrictions[, or civil [fines,] fine in an amount not  
to exceed \$1,000.00 for each day that the violation  
which forms the subject matter of the complaint that  
recommends such disciplinary action continues after  
date on which the City Council establishes a date for  
the consideration of such complaint, or any combination  
[thereof,] of such actions, as the particular situation  
may require. The Council may also impose against the

1 licensee the actual costs incurred, and a reasonable  
2 amount for attorney's fees, resulting from the imposi-  
3 tion of disciplinary action. The disciplinary actions  
4 available in this Section shall be in addition to, and  
5 not exclusive of, any other civil or criminal remedy  
6 which otherwise might be available.

7 SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 88, Section 130, of the  
8 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is  
9 hereby amended to read as follows:

10 6.88.120: After the hearing of a contested matter, the [Board  
11 of Commissioners] City Council shall render a decision  
12 on the merits which shall include findings of fact and  
13 conclusions of law and the penalty to be imposed, if  
14 any, which may, without limitation, include the suspen-  
15 sion or revocation of the respondent's license, approval  
16 for suitability or work card, as the case may be, the  
17 imposition of conditions upon the license, approval for  
18 suitability or work card in question or the imposition  
19 of a fine in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00 for each  
20 day that the violation which forms the subject matter  
21 of the complaint continues after the City Council  
22 approves the complaint, or combination of such suspen-  
23 sion or revocation, imposition of conditions and impo-  
24 sition of fine, and shall thereafter make and enter its  
25 order in its minutes in conformity to such decision.  
26 The decision of the [Board] City Council shall be served  
27 on the parties personally or shall be sent to them by  
28 registered or certified mail. The decision shall become  
29 and remain effective upon such service unless the  
30 [Board] City Council shall otherwise order.

31 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision  
32 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any

1 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or  
2 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,  
3 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of  
4 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.  
5 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby  
6 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-  
7 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof,  
8 irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsec-  
9 tions, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be  
10 declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

11 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sec-  
12 tions, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs  
13 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,  
14 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
