AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TEENAGE ENTERTAINMENT LOCATIONS; AMENDING TITLE 6, CHAPTER 80, SECTION 110, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO AUTHORIZE A WAIVER BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE REQUIRED SEPARATION BETWEEN A PROPOSED TEENAGE ENTERTAINMENT LOCATION AND AN ESTABLISHMENT WHICH DISPENSES ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, BASED UPON A CONSIDERATION OF THE NATURE AND THE CHARACTER OF THE BUSINESSES WITHIN THE SURROUNDING NEIGHBORHOOD; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Provides for Waiver of Required Separation Between Teenage Entertainment Location and Establishment that Dispenses Alcoholic Beverages

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 80, Section 110, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.80.110: No entrance through which patrons may be admitted to a teenage entertainment location shall be permitted within a distance of five hundred feet from the closest customer entrance to any establishment that is described in LVMC Chapter 19.74 or from the closest customer entrance to any tavern or other establishment in which any beer, wine or other alcoholic beverage is served, sold or given away, and no teenage entertainment location shall be permitted within a structure or building that has a roof in common with any of such establishments. At the request of the applicant for a license pursuant to this Chapter, the City Council, in its discretion, may waive the separation between the proposed teenage entertainment location and an establishment which dispenses alcoholic beverages that is
