ORDINANCE NO. 2160

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, TO INCLUDE WITHIN, ANNEX TO AND MAKE A PART OF SAID CITY CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED TERRITORY ADJOINING AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY; DECLARING SAID TERRITORY AND THE INHABITANTS THEREOF TO BE ANNEXED TO SAID CITY AND SUBJECT TO ALL DEBTS, LAWS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS IN FORCE IN SAID CITY; ORDERING A MAP OR PLAT OF SAID DESCRIBED TERRITORY TO BE RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER OF THE COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA; AMENDING THE MAJOR STREET PLAN MAP ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1537 ON OCTOBER 6, 1971 INsofar AS IT RELATES TO TORREY PINES DRIVE AND PEAK DRIVE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.

THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, are hereby extended to include, annex to, and make a part of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, the following described real property, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 60 East, M.D.M., in the County of Clark, State of Nevada, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of said Section 14; thence along the South line of said Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4), South 86°35'01" East 324.38 feet to the East line of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of said Section 14; thence along said East line, North 03°47'22" West 324.79 feet to the North line of said Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4); thence along said North line North 86°17'26" West 322.10 feet to the West line of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of said Section 14; thence along said West line South 03°21'15" East 326.15 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

1 SECTION 2: That said Board of Commissioners has
2 determined and does hereby determine, that said described terri-
3 tory meets the requirements provided by law for annexation to the
4 City of Las Vegas for the following reasons:

5 A. The area to be annexed was contiguous to the
6 City's boundaries at the time the annexation
7 proceedings were instituted;

8 B. More than one-eighth (1/8) of the aggregate
9 external boundaries of the area are contiguous to
10 the City of Las Vegas;

11 C. The territory proposed to be annexed is not
12 included within the boundaries of another incor-
13 porated city;

14 D. The City of Las Vegas is eligible to annex the
15 area described in this report since the landowners
16 have signed a petition requesting annexation to the
17 City, said petition constituting one hundred percent
18 (100%) of the owners of record of individual lots
19 or parcels of land within the annexation area, and
20 have submitted a letter of intent to develop the
21 land.

22 SECTION 3: The City of Las Vegas will provide police
23 protection through the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department,
24 fire protection, street maintenance, and library services
25 immediately upon annexation. Garbage collection by the company
26 franchised by the City will also be provided immediately. The
27 City sanitary sewer system will serve the proposed annexation
28 area. Any connection to or extension of this sewer line to
29 serve the annexation area shall be at the expense of the land-
30 owners. Other services, such as participation in the City's
31 recreational programs, special educational classes and programs,
32 public works planning, building inspections, and other City Hall

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1 services will also be available immediately. Utilities such as
2 gas, electricity, telephone, and water are provided by private
3 utility companies and other services to the area will not be
4 affected by annexation. Street paving, curbs and gutters,
5 sidewalks and street lights which are not in place at the time of
6 annexation will be installed in the presently developed areas
7 upon the request of the property owners and at their expense
8 by means of special assessment districts. Such improvements
9 will be extended into the undeveloped areas as development takes
10 place and the need therefor arises, and will be located according
11 to the needs of the area at that time. Such installations will
12 also be made at the expense of the property owners, either by
13 means of special assessment districts or as prerequisites to the
14 approval of subdivision plats or the issuance of building
15 permits, rezonings, zone variances or special use permits.

16 SECTION 4: The annexation of said described territory
17 shall become effective on the 15th day of May, 1981, and on such
18 date the City of Las Vegas will have the funds appropriated in
19 sufficient amount to finance the extension into said described
20 territory of police protection, fire protection, street maintenance,
21 street sweeping, and street lighting maintenance.

22 SECTION 5: Said described territory, together with
23 the inhabitants and property thereof, shall, from and after the
24 15th day of May, 1981 be subject to all debts, laws, ordinances
25 and regulations in force in the City of Las Vegas and shall be
26 entitled to the same privileges and benefits as other parts of
27 said City, and shall be subject to municipal taxes levied by the
28 City of Las Vegas, Nevada.

29 SECTION 6: The City Engineer of the City of Las Vegas,
30 Nevada, is hereby instructed to cause to be prepared an accurate
31 map or plat of said described territory and to record the same,
32 together with a certified copy of this ordinance in the office

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1 of the County Recorder of Clark County, Nevada, which said
2 recording shall be done prior to the 15th day of May, 1981.

3 SECTION 7: The Major Street Plan of the City of Las
4 Vegas, adopted by Ordinance No. 1537 on October 6, 1971, is
5 hereby amended as follows: Torrey Pines Drive, a Secondary
6 (80 ft. right-of-way) Street, commencing at the centerline of
7 Peak Drive and extending northward 327 feet.

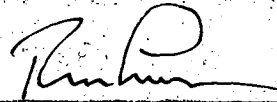
8 SECTION 8: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
9 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any
10 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or
11 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
12 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
13 the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
14 Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares
15 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
16 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of
17 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
18 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
19 tional, invalid or ineffective.

20 SECTION 9: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
21 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
22 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
23 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

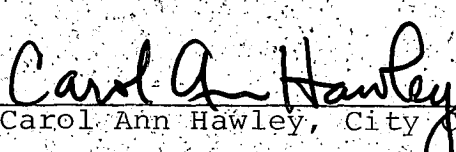
